# Faith Formation & Evangelization



## Social Teaching of the Church Rights and Responsibilities

*"God makes grace abundant for you, so that in all things, you may have an abundance for every good work."*  
2 Corinthians 9:8

Pilgrims of Hope: Our Human Rights / Gifts are to be shared

Three weeks ago we began to reflect on Catholic Social Teaching. Last week we considered the second one, on Call to Family, Community and Participation in Society. This week we are going to consider 'Rights and Responsibilities.' The Catholic tradition teaches that human dignity can be protected and a healthy community can be achieved only if human rights are protected and the responsibilities are met. Therefore, every person has a fundamental right to life and a right to those things required for human decency. Corresponding to these rights are duties and responsibilities -- to one another, to our families, and to the larger society. Pope Benedict XVI explained that *"...individual rights, when detached from a framework of duties which grants them their full meaning, can run wild, leading to an escalation of demands..."* (Caritas in Veritate, #43). Saint John Paul II gives the example claiming, *"...the common outcry ... the right to health, to home, to work, to family, to culture ... is illusory if the right to life, the most basic and fundamental right and the condition for all other personal rights, is not defended..."* (Christifideles Laici, #38). St. John XXIII said to claim one's rights and ignore the duties is like building a house with one hand and tearing it down with the other.

Hace tres semanas comenzamos a reflexionar sobre la doctrina social católica. La semana pasada consideramos la segunda, sobre la llamada a la familia, la comunidad y la participación en la sociedad. Esta semana vamos a considerar «Derechos y Responsabilidades». La tradición católica enseña que sólo se puede proteger la dignidad humana y lograr una comunidad sana si se protegen los derechos humanos y se cumplen las responsabilidades. Por tanto, toda persona tiene un derecho fundamental a la vida y un derecho a las cosas necesarias para la decencia humana. A estos derechos corresponden deberes y responsabilidades: para con los demás, para con nuestras familias y para con la sociedad en general. El Papa Benedicto XVI explicó que «...los derechos individuales, cuando se separan de un marco de deberes que les otorga su pleno significado, pueden desbocarse, llevando a una escalada de exigencias...» (Caritas in Veritate, #43). San Juan Pablo II da el ejemplo afirmando: «...el clamor común... el derecho a la salud, a la casa, al trabajo, a la familia, a la cultura... es ilusorio si no se defiende el derecho a la vida, el derecho más básico y fundamental y la condición de todos los demás derechos personales...» (Christifideles Laici, #38). San Juan XXIII decía que reivindicar los derechos e ignorar los deberes es como construir una casa con una mano y derribarla con la otra.

# Formación en la Fe y Evangelización

**Prepare: 18th Sunday  
in Ordinary Time**

Ecclesiastes 1:2; 2:21-23  
Psalms 90:3-4, 5-6, 12-13, 14 and 17  
Colossians 3:1-5, 9-11  
Luke 12:13-21

## Summary of the Readings:

**First Reading** – The Teacher declares everything meaningless. Working hard, only to leave the results to someone else, is futile. Life is full of pain and worry, and this is also meaningless.

**Responsorial Psalm** – God turns people back to dust, and life is fleeting like grass. Teaches us to value our days and show us compassion. May God's favor be upon us and our work.

**Second Reading** – Focus on what is above, not on earthly things. Put to death sinful behaviors and renew yourself in Christ. Christ is everything and in everyone.

**Gospel** – Jesus warns against greed and tells a parable of a rich man focused on storing wealth. God calls him a fool, reminding us that life is about being rich toward God.

Our readings next Sunday call us to examine our values and priorities. In the Gospel, Jesus tells a parable of a man who stores up many possessions, thinking he has secured his future. The man's wealth is ultimately meaningless, with nothing lasting to show for his work. In the end, his greed lead his heart away from God and isolated himself from others.

## Reflect:

- ♦ What is the difference in relying on God rather than on our wealth or success?
- ♦ How can greed or selfishness affect your relationship with God and others?
- ♦ How can you focus on eternal values this week? How might your life change if you practice this focus often?
- ♦ Pray with Psalm 90:3-17.

**Salmo responsorial** Dios convierte a las personas en polvo, y la vida es fugaz como la hierba. Enséñanos a valorar nuestros días y muéstranos compasión. Que el favor de Dios sea con nosotros y con nuestro trabajo.

**Segunda lectura** - Fijaos en lo de arriba, no en las cosas terrenas. Haz morir los comportamientos pecaminosos y renuévate en Cristo. Cristo es todo y en todos.

**Evangelio** - Jesús advierte contra la avaricia y cuenta la parábola de un hombre rico centrado en almacenar riquezas. Dios le llama necio, recordándonos que la vida consiste en ser rico para con Dios.

Nuestras lecturas del próximo domingo nos invitan a examinar nuestros valores y prioridades. En el Evangelio, Jesús cuenta la parábola de un hombre que acumula muchas posesiones, pensando que ha asegurado su futuro. Al final, la riqueza de este hombre carece de sentido, sin nada duradero que mostrar por su trabajo. Al final, su avaricia aleja su corazón de Dios y le aísla de los demás.

- ♦ ¿Cuál es la diferencia entre confiar en Dios y hacerlo en nuestras riquezas o nuestro éxito?
- ♦ ¿Cómo pueden afectar la codicia o el egoísmo a tu relación con Dios y con los demás?
- ♦ ¿Cómo puedes centrarte en los valores eternos esta semana? ¿Cómo podría cambiar tu vida si practicaras este enfoque con frecuencia?
- ♦ Ora con el Salmo 90:3-17.

# Liturgy of the Word

## SEVENTEETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### READING 1 GN 18:20-32

In those days, the LORD said: "The outcry against Sodom and Gomorrah is so great, and their sin so grave, that I must go down and see whether or not their actions fully correspond to the cry against them that comes to me. I mean to find out."

While Abraham's visitors walked on farther toward Sodom, the LORD remained standing before Abraham. Then Abraham drew nearer and said: "Will you sweep away the innocent with the guilty? Suppose there were fifty innocent people in the city; would you wipe out the place, rather than spare it for the sake of the fifty innocent people within it? Far be it from you to do such a thing, to make the innocent die with the guilty so that the innocent and the guilty would be treated alike! Should not the judge of all the world act with justice?" The LORD replied, "If I find fifty innocent people in the city of Sodom, I will spare the whole place for their sake." Abraham spoke up again: "See how I am presuming to speak to my Lord, though I am but dust and ashes! What if there are five less than fifty innocent people? Will you destroy the whole city because of those five?" He answered, "I will not destroy it, if I find forty-five there." But Abraham persisted, saying "What if only forty are found there?" He replied, "I will forbear doing it for the sake of the forty." Then Abraham said, "Let not my Lord grow impatient if I go on. What if only thirty are found there?" He replied, "I will forbear doing it if I can find but thirty there." Still Abraham went on, "Since I have thus dared to speak to my Lord, what if there are no more than twenty?" The LORD answered, "I will not destroy it, for the sake of the twenty." But he still persisted: "Please, let not my Lord grow angry if I speak up this last time. What if there are at least ten there?" He replied, "For the sake of those ten, I will not destroy it."

### READING 2 COL 2:12-14

Brothers and sisters:

You were buried with him in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through faith in the power of God, who raised him from the dead. And even when you were dead in transgressions and the uncircumcision of your flesh, he brought you to life along with him, having forgiven us all our transgressions; obliterating the bond against us, with its legal claims, which was opposed to us, he also removed it from our midst, nailing it to the cross.

### GOSPEL LK 11:1-13

Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when he had finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray just as John taught his disciples." He said to them, "When you pray, say: Father, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come. Give us each day our daily bread and forgive us our sins for we ourselves forgive everyone in debt to us, and do not subject us to the final test."

And he said to them, "Suppose one of you has a friend to whom he goes at midnight and says, 'Friend, lend me three loaves of bread, for a friend of mine has arrived at my house from a journey and I have nothing to offer him,' and he says in reply from within, 'Do not bother me; the door has already been locked and my children and I are already in bed. I cannot get up to give you anything.' I tell you, if he does not get up to give the visitor the loaves because of their friendship, he will get up to give him whatever he needs because of his persistence.

"And I tell you, ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks, receives; and the one who seeks, finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened. What father among you would hand his son a snake when he asks for a fish? Or hand him a scorpion when he asks for an egg? If you then, who are wicked, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?"

# Liturgia de la Palabra

## XVII DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO 27 DE JULIO DE 2025

### **PRIMERA LECTURA**      **GEN 18, 20-32**

En aquellos días, el Señor dijo a Abraham: "El clamor contra Sodoma y Gomorra es grande y su pecado es demasiado grave. Bajaré, pues, a ver si sus hechos corresponden a ese clamor; y si no, lo sabré".

Los hombres que estaban con Abraham se despidieron de él y se encaminaron hacia Sodoma. Abraham se quedó ante el Señor y le preguntó: "¿Será posible que tú destruyas al inocente junto con el culpable? Supongamos que hay cincuenta justos en la ciudad, ¿acabarás con todos ellos y no perdonarás al lugar en atención a esos cincuenta justos? Lejos de ti tal cosa: matar al inocente junto con el culpable, de manera que la suerte del justo sea como la del malvado; eso no puede ser. El juez de todo el mundo ¿no hará justicia?" El Señor le contestó: "Si encuentro en Sodoma cincuenta justos, perdonaré a toda la ciudad en atención a ellos".

Abraham insistió: "Me he atrevido a hablar a mi Señor, yo que soy polvo y ceniza. Supongamos que faltan cinco para los cincuenta justos, ¿por esos cinco que faltan, destruirás toda la ciudad?" Y le respondió el Señor: "No la destruiré, si encuentro allí cuarenta y cinco justos".

Abraham volvió a insistir: "Quizá no se encuentren allí más que cuarenta". El Señor le respondió: "En atención a los cuarenta, no lo haré".

Abraham siguió insistiendo: "Que no se enoje mi Señor, si sigo hablando, ¿y si hubiera treinta?" El Señor le dijo: "No lo haré, si hay treinta".

Abraham insistió otra vez: "Ya que me he atrevido a hablar a mi Señor, ¿y si se encuentran sólo veinte?" El Señor respondió: "En atención a los veinte, no la destruiré".

Abraham continuó: "No se enoje mi Señor, hablaré sólo una vez más, ¿y si se encuentran sólo diez?" Contestó el Señor: "Por esos diez, no destruiré la ciudad".

Porque quien pide, recibe; quien busca, encuentra, y al que toca, se le abre. ¿Habrá entre ustedes algún padre que, cuando su hijo le pida pan, le dé una piedra? ¿O cuando le pida pescado, le dé una víbora? ¿O cuando le pida huevo, le dé un alacrán? Pues, si ustedes, que son malos, saben dar cosas buenas a sus hijos, ¿cuánto más el Padre celestial dará el Espíritu Santo a quienes se lo pidan?"

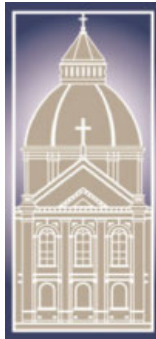

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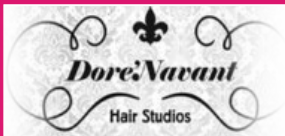
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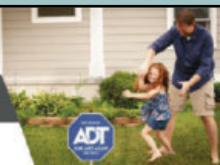
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
