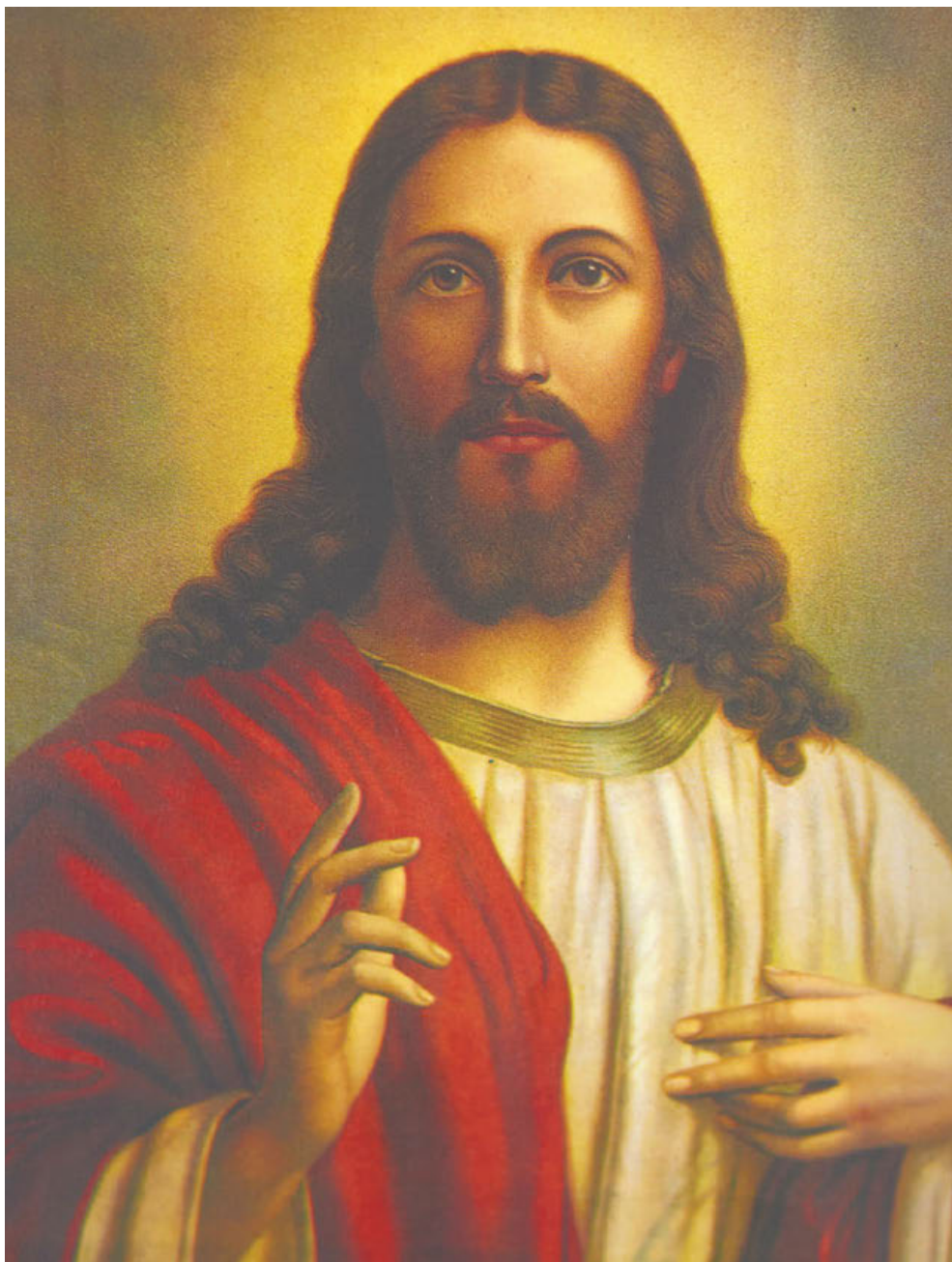

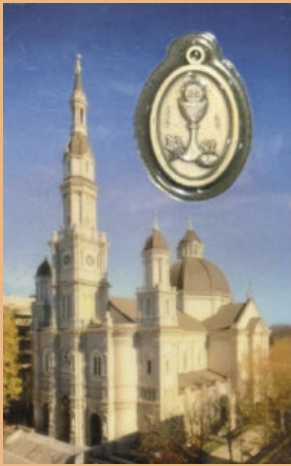

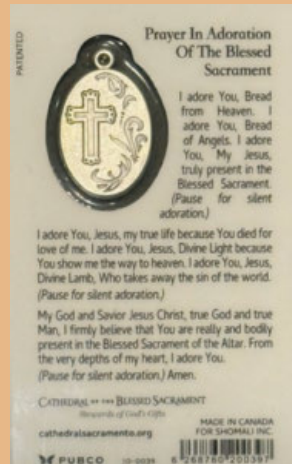

Summary of the Readings:

- **First Reading** – Sirach 3:17-18, 20, 28-29: Be humble in all you do, and you will be loved. Seek wisdom, avoid what is beyond you, and give alms to atone for sins.
- **Responsorial Psalm** – Psalm 68: God provides for the poor and needy, giving them a home and bringing joy to the righteous. He protects orphans and widows, and revives the land for his people.
- **Second Reading** – Hebrews 12:18-19, 22-24A: You have come to the heavenly Jerusalem, where angels and the righteous gather, and Jesus mediates a new covenant with his powerful, redemptive blood.
- **Gospel** – Luke 14:1, 7-14: Jesus taught about humility, advising guests to take the lowest place and hosts to invite those who cannot repay. He promised that those who humble themselves will be exalted and will be rewarded at the resurrection.

The 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C brings us a strong message about humility. Jesus reminds us not to seek praise or high places. Instead, he shows us that real honor comes when we let go of pride. Those who lift themselves up will be brought down, but those who stay low will be raised up by God.

Reflect:

- ♦ How can I practice humility in my daily life?
- ♦ Why is it important to depend on God rather than seek praise from others?
- ♦ In what ways can I show generosity without expecting anything in return?
- ♦ Pray with Psalm 68

Resumen de las lecturas:

- **Primera Lectura** - Eclesiástico 3:17-18, 20, 28-29: Sé humilde en todo lo que hagas, y serás amado. Busca la sabiduría, evita lo que te sobrepasa y da limosna para expiar los pecados.
- **Salmo responsorial** - Salmo 68: Dios provee a los pobres y necesitados, les da un hogar y alegría a los justos. Protege a los huérfanos y a las viudas, y reaviva la tierra para su pueblo.
- **Segunda lectura** - Hebreos 12:18-19, 22-24A: Habéis llegado a la Jerusalén celestial, donde se reúnen los ángeles y los justos, y Jesús media una nueva alianza con su poderosa sangre redentora.
- **Evangelio** - Lucas 14:1, 7-14: Jesús enseñó sobre la humildad, aconsejando a los invitados que ocuparan el lugar más bajo y a los anfitriones que invitaran a los que no podían pagar. Prometió que los que se humillan serán exaltados y serán recompensados en la resurrección.

El 22º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario del Año C nos trae un mensaje contundente sobre la humildad. Jesús nos recuerda que no debemos buscar alabanzas ni altos cargos. En cambio, nos muestra que el verdadero honor llega cuando nos desprendemos del orgullo. Los que se elevan serán derribados, pero los que permanecen humildes serán elevados por Dios.

Reflejar:

- ♦ ¿Cómo puedo practicar la humildad en mi vida diaria?
- ♦ ¿Por qué es importante depender de Dios en lugar de buscar la alabanza de los demás?
- ♦ ¿De qué manera puedo mostrar generosidad sin esperar nada a cambio?
- ♦ Reza con el Salmo 68

READING 1 IS 66:18-21

Thus says the LORD:

I know their works and their thoughts, and I come to gather nations of every language; they shall come and see my glory. SEGUNDA LECTURA HEB 12, 5-7. 11-13

Hermanos: Ya se han olvidado ustedes de la exhortación que Dios les dirigió, como a hijos, diciendo: Hijo mío, no desprecies la corrección del Señor, ni te desanimes cuando te reprenda. Porque el Señor corrige a los que ama, y da azotes a sus hijos predilectos. Soporten, pues, la corrección, porque Dios los trata como a hijos; ¿y qué padre hay que no corrija a sus hijos?

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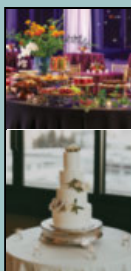
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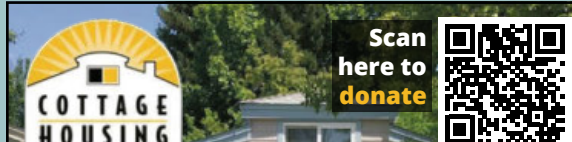
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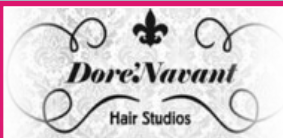
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
