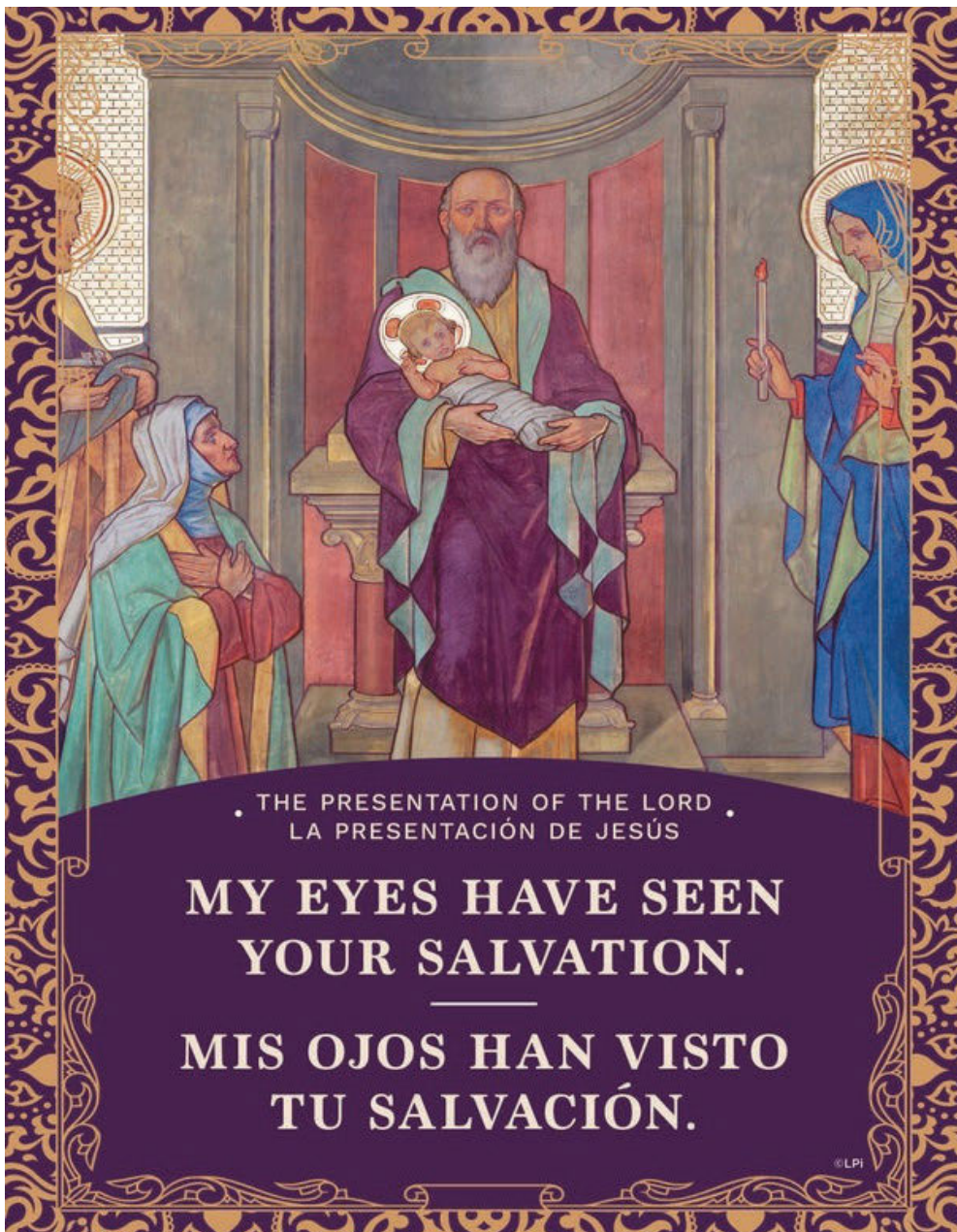

A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥160 (Matt 瑪11:20-24)

Fr. Abraham Chiu 趙必成神父

加里肋亞人罪行如何看見？他們也需要身披苦衣頭上撒灰表示悔改？原因簡單：他們沒有認識耶穌所行“異能”是在召叫人悔改；對耶穌冷漠，源自靈性驕傲。

耶穌說：“苛辣匝因，你是有禍的！貝特賽達，你是有禍的！因為在你們那裡所行的異能，如果行在提洛和漆冬，她們早已身披苦衣，頭上撒灰做補贖了。”

動詞“做補贖” (metenoēsān) 本意悔改，指向罪人對自己所犯的罪感到歉意，並準備遠離魔鬼。在瑪4:17中，耶穌以“悔改”開始宣講：“你們悔改吧！因為天國臨近了。”表達悔改的迫切。

感嘆詞“有禍的” (ouai) 是強烈不滿的表達，這“不滿”非消極，是積極為那些自以為是的人的悔改而說。每個人，從上到下，都必須面對審判的日子，無一例外。

耶穌說：“在審判的日子，索多瑪地所受的懲罰也要比你們容易忍受。”名詞“審判” (kriseōs) 本是法庭術語，在宗教上，是指默西亞耶穌的宣講與牧職，將成為所有拒絕悔改以及不願跟隨他的罪人的審判。也就是說，如果他們悔改，永生就垂手可得。換言之，天國屬於所有悔改者，不屬於自以為是的人。

虔誠基督徒會吸引他人加入教會，如玫瑰以其美麗芬芳吸引人們一樣。締造美麗芬芳的基本要素，非嘮嘮叨叨，是悔改。悔改是精神殉道，因為誰要接近天主，就必須放棄犯罪快感。這種十字架的精神死亡，毫無疑問，會把人帶進天國。

Santo Niño Fiesta Celebration



Viva Pit Señor!

The Cathedral Filipino-American Ministry thanks and appreciates everyone who attended the 24th Annual Santo Niño Fiesta Celebration on Saturday, January 11.

Held in the honor of the child Jesus, the celebration included a novena, offering of flowers to the Santo Niño, and a bilingual mass concelebrated by Bishop Rey Bersabal, Father Michael O'Reilly, and Deacon Edgar Hilbert. The fellowship reception after the Mass in Mercy Hall was a joyous gathering featuring Filipino cuisine, a traditional Sinulog dance venerating Santo Niño, and cultural performances by the Natomas Dancers from Divine Mercy Parish.

The explorer Ferdinand Magellan gifted the image of the Santo Niño to Cebu's queen at her baptism in 1521, thus marking the moment of Christianity's arrival in the Philippines.

The image of Santo Niño represents Jesus Christ as an infant, wearing a white vest that symbolizes his Resurrection and a crimson cape that recalls his Most Precious Blood. The image has a crown, a reference to Jesus' universal kingship. It also has a scepter on its right and an orb topped by a cross on its left hand, symbolizing Jesus' authority and sovereignty.

Jubilee Year of Hope: The Holy Trinity is our 'Electricity'

Imagine for a moment that your family must go a whole week without electricity of any kind. If your family is anything like ours, it would mean doing without A LOT! No lights, no refrigerator, no oven, no stove, no heat or cooling, no microwave, no hot water, no washer or dryer, no wi-fi no phone or computer, no noise making toys (not necessarily a bad thing), no car or bus or uber, and most importantly NO COFFEE! Let's face it, life as we know it and experience it wouldn't be possible without electricity.

That's a lot like the Christian life. We need power, strength, and grace to follow Jesus and to live like Jesus, love like Jesus, and pray like Jesus. That power is the Holy Spirit. It's not just more challenging to do it without Him, it's absolutely impossible. Jesus knew we needed his Holy Spirit. That is why he told His apostles in John Chapter 16 *"But I tell you the truth, it is better for you that I go. For if I do not go, the Advocate (which is a title for the Holy Spirit) will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you."* Think about that for a minute. The apostles had Jesus Himself sitting with them, talking with them. And yet Jesus said it's better if I go, so that the Holy Spirit will come. This month, we are unpacking the Holy Trinity, our real power.



Imagine por un momento que su familia debe pasar una semana entera sin electricidad de ningún tipo. Si tu familia es como la nuestra, ¡significaría prescindir de MUCHÍSIMO! Sin luz, sin frigorífico, sin horno, sin cocina, sin calefacción ni refrigeración, sin microondas, sin agua caliente, sin lavadora ni secadora, sin wi-fi, sin teléfono ni ordenador, sin juguetes que hagan ruido (lo cual no es necesariamente malo), sin coche ni autobús ni Uber y, lo más importante, ¡SIN CAFÉ! Afrontémoslo, la vida tal y como la conocemos y experimentamos no sería posible sin electricidad. Eso se parece mucho a la vida cristiana. Necesitamos poder, fuerza y gracia para seguir a Jesús y vivir como Jesús, amar como Jesús y orar como Jesús. Ese poder es el Espíritu Santo. No solo es mas difícil hacerlo sin El, es absolutamente imposible.

Jesús sabía que necesitábamos su Espíritu Santo. Por eso les dijo a sus apóstoles en Juan capítulo 16 «Pero les aseguro que es mejor para ustedes que yo me vaya. Porque si no me voy, el Abogado (que es un título para el Espíritu Santo) no vendrá a ustedes. Pero si yo voy, os lo enviaré». Piensa en eso por un minuto. Los apóstoles tenían a Jesús mismo sentado con ellos, hablando con ellos. Y sin embargo, Jesús dijo que es mejor que me vaya, para que venga el Espíritu Santo. Este mes, estamos desentrañando la Santísima Trinidad, nuestro verdadero poder.

Pray an Act of Love to God:

O my God, I love you above all things, with my whole heart and soul, because You are all-good and worthy of my love of you. I forgive all who have injured me, and I ask pardon of all whom I have injured. Amen.

Focus of the Gospel:

Have you ever worked hard at something only to come up empty-handed? Maybe it was studying for an exam and it didn't go as well as you needed. Perhaps a job interview and you didn't get a call back. Simon the fisherman understands what it feels like to work hard and get nothing for his work. He was on the lake all night fishing, and didn't catch a thing. As the morning sun was rising, he was cleaning his nets and looking forward to going to bed and hopefully have a better night tomorrow. While he and his partners were on the lake fishing, a crowd was listening to Jesus' every word. Jesus got in the boat to teach, maybe so his voice would echo off the water better for people to hear. And then Jesus said to Simon to go back out on the water and lower his nets. Simon doesn't really want to; he's been at it all night but something about this Jesus made him do it anyway. He lowered his nets knowing that it wasn't the time or the place to fish. Imagine his surprise when his nets filled with so many fish that his boat might sink! At that moment Simon's life was changed (and his name too). He experienced the Messiah for himself. Not only were his boats filled with fish, but his heart was cleansed of all doubt—Jesus is Lord. And his heart was ready to follow Him.

Enfoque del evangelio:

¿Alguna vez te has esforzado en algo y te has quedado con las manos vacías? Puede que estudiaras para un examen y no te saliera todo lo bien que necesitabas. Tal vez una entrevista de trabajo y no te han devuelto la llamada. Simón, el pescador, sabe lo que es trabajar duro y no recibir nada a cambio. Estuvo toda la noche pescando en el lago y no pescó nada. Al salir el sol de la mañana, estaba limpiando sus redes y deseando irse a la cama y, con suerte, tener una noche mejor mañana. Mientras él y sus compañeros estaban en el lago pescando, una multitud escuchaba cada palabra de Jesús. Jesús subió a la barca para enseñar, tal vez para que su voz resonara mejor en el agua y la gente pudiera oírlo. Entonces Jesús le dice a Simón que vuelva al agua y eche las redes. Simón no tenía muchas ganas de hacerlo; había estado en ello toda la noche, pero algo en Jesús le hizo hacerlo de todos modos. Echó las redes sabiendo que no era el momento ni el lugar para pescar. Imagínate su sorpresa cuando sus redes se llenaron de tantos peces que su barca podría hundirse. En ese momento cambió la vida de Simón (y también su nombre). Experimentó al Mesías por sí mismo. No sólo sus barcas se llenaron de peces, sino que su corazón quedó limpio de toda duda: Jesús es el Señor. Y su corazón estaba dispuesto a seguirle.

sword will pierce- so that the thoughts of
many hearts may be revealed." There was
also a prophetess, Anna, the daughter of
Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was
advanced in years, having lived seven years
with her husband after her marriage, and
then as a widow until she was eighty-four.
She never left the temple, but worshiped
night and day with fasting and prayer. And
coming forward at that very time, she gave
thanks to God and spoke about the child to
all who were awaiting the redemption of
Jerusalem.

When they had fulfilled all the
prescriptions of the law of the Lord, they
returned to Galilee, to their own town of
Nazareth. The child grew and became
strong, filled with wisdom; and the favor of
God was upon him.

No se apartaba del templo ni de día ni de noche, sirviendo a Dios con ayunos y oraciones. Ana se acercó en aquel momento, dando gracias a Dios y hablando del niño a todos los que aguardaban la liberación de Israel.

Y cuando cumplieron todo lo que prescribía la ley del Señor, se volvieron a Galilea, a su ciudad de Nazaret. El niño iba creciendo y fortaleciéndose, se llenaba de sabiduría y la gracia de Dios estaba con él.

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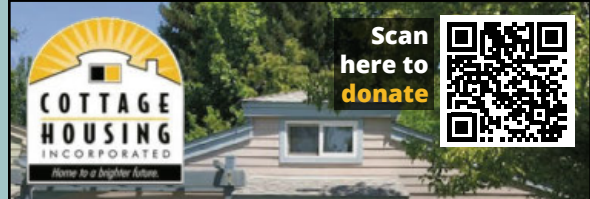
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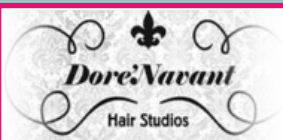
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
