PUEDA DONAR EN LÍNEA

Sunday, March 2 - Special Collection for Repairs and Maintenance

Our gorgeous Cathedral is old and continually needs repairs and maintenance. Please give generously next week at the First Sunday Special Collection for lighting and restoration of art, specifically Luke and the Gospel saints around the rotunda. The target is \$150,000 because we will need to hire scaffolding to reach the pendentives and lighting at the base of the dome. Pendentives are the triangular areas formed when a round dome is built over a square room. Inside the Cathedral's pendentives are beautifully painted, giant canvases of the Gospel Saints which were glued to the surface during the 2005 restoration. Unfortunately, the adhesive has deteriorated, and in December 2021, Saint Luke fell off the wall. It is no small undertaking to reach the pendentives as it requires expensive, massive scaffolding, not to mention the skilled labor needed to mount the canvas of Saint Luke. While the scaffolding is up, experts will check the integrity of the other Saints to make sure their canvases don't detach. Additionally, repairs and updates to the hard-to-reach lighting will also take place.

El próximo domingo 2 de marzo Colección Especial para Reparaciones y Mantenimiento

Nuestra hermosa Catedral es antigua y necesita continuamente reparaciones y mantenimiento. Por favor, done generosamente la próxima semana en la Colecta Especial del Primer Domingo para la iluminación y restauración de las obras de arte, específicamente de Lucas y los santos del Evangelio alrededor de la rotunda. El objetivo es \$150,000 porque necesitaremos contratar andamios para llegar a las pechinas y la iluminación en la base de la cúpula. Las pechinas son las áreas triangulares que se forman cuando se construye una cúpula redonda sobre una habitación cuadrada. Dentro de las pechinas de la Catedral hay lienzos gigantes bellamente pintados de los santos del Evangelio que se pegaron a la superficie durante la restauración de 2005. Desafortunadamente, la humedad y la edad han provocado el deterioro del adhesivo y, en diciembre de 2021, San Lucas se cayó de la pared. No es una tarea fácil llegar a las pechinas en la base de la cúpula, ya que requiere un andamio costoso y masivo, sin mencionar la mano de obra calificada necesaria para montar el lienzo de San Lucas. Mientras se colocan los andamios, los expertos comprobarán la integridad de los demás santos para asegurarse de que sus lonas no se desprendan. Además, también se realizarán reparaciones y actualizaciones en la iluminación, que es de difícil acceso.

Pilgrims of Hope: We Pray for our Confirmation Youth

Every year, as part of their preparation for Confirmation our youth Candidates go to FIRED UP, a Conference experience with other Confirmation Youth throughout the Diocese. This past Saturday, our youth went to Christian Brothers High School to participate with other Candidates from many parts of the Diocese. The Conference had three points:

- 1) giving students who are about to receive the Sacrament the experience of being called by God to receive the Sacrament;
 - 2) connecting directly with their bishop, not unlike the Rite of Election in the RCIA process, and
 - 3) calling these students to engage in the period of continuing conversion and formation following their Confirmation.
- We ask that you pray for our youth, that their hearts may be "Fired Up" to serve God.



Cada año, como parte de su preparación para la Confirmación nuestros jóvenes Candidatos van a FIRED UP, una experiencia de Conferencia con otros Jóvenes de Confirmación de toda la Diócesis. Este sábado pasado, nuestros jóvenes fueron a Christian Brothers High School para participar con otros Candidatos de muchas partes de la Diócesis. La Conferencia tuvo tres puntos:

- 1) dar a los estudiantes que están a punto de recibir el Sacramento la experiencia de ser llamados por Dios a recibir el Sacramento;
- 2) conectar directamente con su obispo, no muy diferente al Rito de Elección en el proceso de RCIA, y
- 3) llamar los estudiantes a comprometerse en el período de conversión y formación continua después de su Confirmación. Os pedimos que recéis por nuestros jóvenes, para que sus corazones estén «Encendidos» para servir a Dios.

Focus of the Gospel:

Sometimes when we read the Sacred Scriptures they can leave us feeling puzzled by what we just read. It really is a different kind of reading than picking up a textbook or scrolling through an app for the quick answer. God's word is an invitation to a deeper understanding of the One who spoke the word: God Himself. So this week, let us look at a process that can be very useful to begin to establish a personal encounter with God in His Word. Below are some simple steps that you can do on your own, or in your family. As you walk through the process, be sure to do so at a time when you are free from distraction (which means we have to carve out time away from those distractions / attractions in life, and give God some of your time in a holy appointment. Doing it with others can be a way to keep us accountable. Ready?

Alone or with your Family / Friends

Gospel Reflection Process

- ◆ Pray a simple prayer to the Holy Spirit: "Speak, Lord, your servant is listening."
- ◆ Read the passage slowly. As you listen, ask in silence, "Lord, what are you saying to me in this passage?"
- ◆ Listen for a word or phrase that calls your attention or touches your heart.
- ◆ Share a brief story or experience of how the word or phrase connects to your life at this moment.
- ◆ Ask in silence, "Lord, what do you want me to do?" Share what Jesus is inviting you to do.
- ◆ Pray a prayer of gratitude to God.

Enfoque del evangelio:

A veces, la lectura de las Sagradas Escrituras puede dejarnos perplejos. Es un tipo de lectura diferente a la de un libro de texto o a la de una aplicación para encontrar una respuesta rápida. La Palabra de Dios es una invitación a una comprensión más profunda de Aquel que pronunció la Palabra: Dios mismo. Así que esta semana, veamos un proceso que puede ser muy útil para comenzar a establecer un encuentro personal con Dios en Su Palabra. A continuación encontrarás algunos pasos sencillos que puedes seguir tú solo o en familia. Mientras recorres el proceso, asegúrate de hacerlo en un momento en que estés libre de distracciones (lo que significa que tenemos que sacar tiempo lejos de esas distracciones / atracciones de la vida, y darle a Dios algo de tu tiempo en una cita santa. Hacerlo con otros puede ser una manera de mantenernos responsables. ¿Preparado?

- ◆ Rezar una oración simple al Espíritu Santo: "Habla, Señor, tu siervo escucha."
- ◆ Leer lentamente el pasaje, y mientras escuchar, preguntar en silencio: "Señor, ¿qué me estás diciendo a mí en este pasaje?"
- ◆ Escuchar por una palabra o frase que llame su atención o toque su corazón.
- ◆ Compartir una breve historia o experiencia de cómo la palabra o frase que está escuchando se conecta con su vida en este momento.
- ◆ Preguntar en silencio, "Señor, ¿qué me estás pidiendo a mí que haga?" y compartir lo que Jesús le invita a hacer.
- ◆ Reza una oración de gratitud a Dios.

Liturgy of the Word

SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

FEBRUARY 23, 2025

READING 1

1 SM 26:2, 7-9, 12-13, 22-23

In those days, Saul went down to the desert of Ziph with three thousand picked men of Israel, to search for David in the desert of Ziph. So David and Abishai went among Saul's soldiers by night and found Saul lying asleep within the barricade, with his spear thrust into the ground at his head and Abner and his men sleeping around him.

Abishai whispered to David: "God has delivered your enemy into your grasp this day. Let me nail him to the ground with one thrust of the spear; I will not need a second thrust!" But David said to Abishai, "Do not harm him, for who can lay hands on the LORD's anointed and remain unpunished?" So David took the spear and the water jug from their place at Saul's head, and they got away without anyone's seeing or knowing or awakening. All remained asleep, because the LORD had put them into a deep slumber.

Going across to an opposite slope, David stood on a remote hilltop at a great distance from Abner, son of Ner, and the troops. He said: "Here is the king's spear. Let an attendant come over to get it. The LORD will reward each man for his justice and faithfulness. Today, though the LORD delivered you into my grasp, I would not harm the LORD's anointed."

Brothers and sisters:

It is written, The first man, Adam, became a living being, the last Adam a life-giving spirit. But the spiritual was not first; rather the natural and then the spiritual. The first man was from the earth, earthly; the second man, from heaven. As was the earthly one, so also are the earthly, and as is the heavenly one, so also are the heavenly. SAM 26, 2. 7-9. 12-13. 22-23
