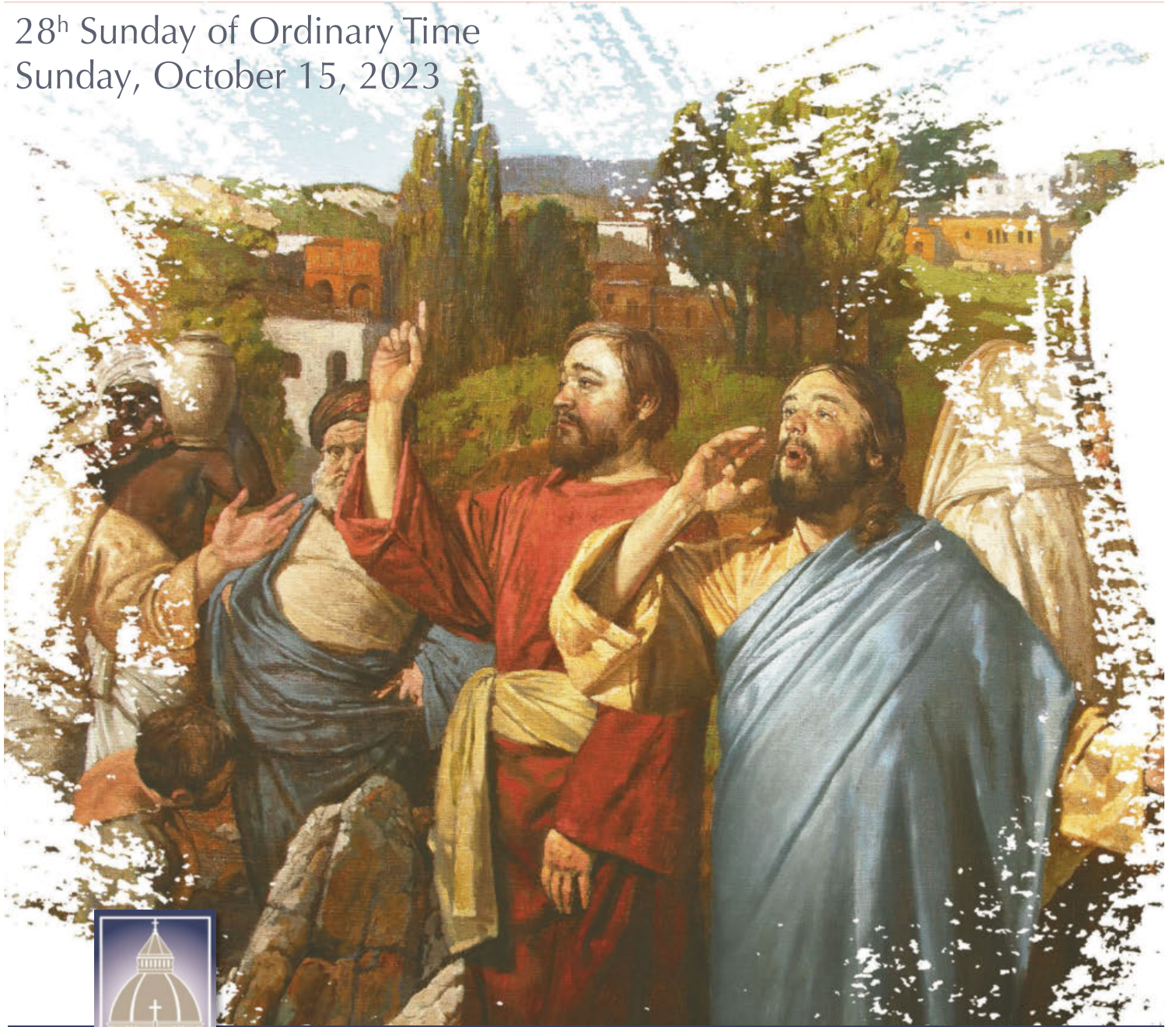

Stewardship Reflection

How easy it is, especially in these times, to be consumed by the cares and distractions of the "here and now," forgetting about what matters most — living for the Kingdom of Heaven. The stewardship way of life, with its emphasis on the virtuous use of our Time, Talent, and Treasure, allows us to embrace daily life and all its demands — with eternity in mind.

How do we keep focused on the Kingdom of Heaven? St. Paul shares his secret for an eternity-driven life. In our Second Reading from his Letter to the Philippians, Paul says, "I know how to live in humble circumstances; I know also how to live with abundance. In every circumstance and in all things I have learned the secret of being well fed and going hungry, of living in abundance and of being in need." In other words, Paul has learned to live the stewardship way of life.

What is the secret? It is this: "I can do all things in him who strengthens me." How? Through this: "My God will fully supply whatever you need, in accord with his glorious riches in Christ Jesus." It is so simple! But it is not easy. It takes both courage and humility to live this way. God will supply these to us if we ask.

Reflexión sobre la mayordomía

Qué fácil es, especialmente en estos tiempos, ser consumido por las preocupaciones y distracciones del "aquí y ahora", olvidándose de lo que más importa: vivir para el Reino de los Cielos. La forma de vida de mayordomía, con su énfasis en el uso virtuoso de nuestro Tiempo, Talento y Tesoro, nos permite abrazar la vida diaria y todas sus demandas, con la eternidad en mente.

¿Cómo nos mantenemos enfocados en el Reino de los Cielos? San Pablo comparte su secreto para una vida impulsada por la eternidad. En nuestra segunda lectura de su Carta a los Filipenses, Pablo dice: "Sé cómo vivir en circunstancias humildes; También sé cómo vivir con abundancia. En cada circunstancia y en todas las cosas he aprendido el secreto de estar bien alimentado y pasar hambre, de vivir en abundancia y de estar en necesidad". En otras palabras, Pablo ha aprendido a vivir el estilo de vida de mayordomía.

¿Cuál es el secreto? Es esta: "Todo lo puedo en aquel que me fortalece". ¿Cómo? A través de esto: "Mi Dios proveerá plenamente todo lo que necesites, de acuerdo con sus gloriosas riquezas en Cristo Jesús". ¡Es tan simple! Pero no es fácil. Se necesita coraje y humildad para vivir de esta manera. Dios nos los proveerá si se los pedimos.

READING 1 IS 25:6-10A

On this mountain the LORD of hosts will provide for all peoples a feast of rich food and choice wines, juicy, rich food and pure, choice wines. On this mountain he will destroy the veil that veils all peoples, the web that is woven over all nations; he will destroy death forever. The Lord GOD will wipe away the tears from every face; the reproach of his people he will remove from the whole earth; for the LORD has spoken. On that day it will be said: "Behold our God, to whom we looked to save us! This is the LORD for whom we looked; let us rejoice and be glad that he has saved us!" For the hand of the LORD will rest on this mountain.

GOSPEL MATTHEW 22:1-14

Jesus again in reply spoke to the chief priests and elders of the people in parables, saying, "The kingdom of heaven may be likened to a king who gave a wedding feast for his son. He dispatched his servants to summon the invited guests to the feast, but they refused to come. A second time he sent other servants, saying, 'Tell those invited: "Behold, I have prepared my banquet, my calves and fattened cattle are killed, and everything is ready; come to the feast."' Some ignored the invitation and went away, one to his farm, another to his business. The rest laid hold of his servants, mistreated them, and killed them. The king was enraged and sent his troops, destroyed those murderers, and burned their city. Then he said to his servants, 'The feast is ready, but those who were invited were not worthy to come. Go out, therefore, into the main roads and invite to the feast whomever you find.' The servants went out into the streets and gathered all they found, bad and good alike, and the hall was filled with guests. But when the king came in to meet the guests, he saw a man there not dressed in a wedding garment. The king said to him, 'My friend, how is it that you came in here without a wedding garment?' But he was reduced to silence. Then the king said to his attendants, 'Bind his hands and feet, and cast him into the darkness outside, where there will be wailing and grinding of teeth.' Many are invited, but few are chosen."

Los criados salieron a los caminos y reunieron a todos los que encontraron, malos y buenos, y la sala del banquete se llenó de convidados.

- ◆ *Where there is imbalance, talk about what can be lessened to make room for the important things.*
- ◆ *Close by praying Psalm 96*

Our life of prayer distinguishes our Catholic life, but even more important, it is our lifeline—it is where we experience God's presence and where we form relationship with Him.

Practice it! What are some things your family can do to start your day with God?

- ◆ Make the Sign of the Cross when you wake up
- ◆ Pray a Morning Offering to God, a good way to give God the glory of all your prayers, works and actions.
- ◆ Practice your Scripture Memory verse (John 4:14).
- ◆ Pray 1 Our Father, 1 Hail Mary and 1 Glory Be
- ◆ Invite God to go with you for the day.
- ◆ Bless your children before leaving the house.

Nuestro Salvavidas: Una Vida de Oración

Nuestra Formación de Fe Familiar está oficialmente en marcha. Nuestro inicio comenzó con un recorrido autoguiado sobre nuestra vida de oración: nuestra Línea de Vida. A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥 93 (Luke 9:1-6)

Even though the Pharisees saw the common people as chaff to be destroyed and burned up, Jesus saw them as a harvest to be reaped and saved.

The disciples were given the authority to love, not to judge, which included involvement in liberating people from the evil power which oppressed them, whether physical or spiritual. Then, Jesus sent them to preach and work. One of the main issues is that the healing ministry underscores exorcism and healing: “he called the twelve together and gave them power and authority over all demons and to cure diseases.” The noun “power” (dynamis) denotes that through the power which the disciples exerted upon the people by performing miracles. The term “authority” (exousia) refers to the inner power of the disciples that their authority is able to destroy the evil power. In short, the disciples were entrusted by Jesus to heal the wounded world in particular, getting rid of the influence of the devil.

The spiritually dead are resurrected and revitalized by the good news preached to them. Particularly, casting out demons also included liberating people from their evil habits and addictions which led them to sin. Being healer is to love one another so that everyone can see the face of God. As Christians share Jesus’ mission, we can bring healing and wholeness to people with whom we come into contact.

Exorcising the demons means rehabilitating and bringing back fully into our communities all those who, for one reason or another, are marginalized, rejected, or despised. Demons are all those suffocating and enslaving forces which dominate, manipulate and restrict our freedom to live in truth and love but we are called to love and heal, and finally, to see the face of God.

儘管法利塞人將普通老百姓視為地下泥，耶穌卻將他們視為要拯救的莊稼。

耶穌召喚門徒，是賦予他們愛的力量，包括將人從壓迫他們的邪惡力量中解放出來，無論是身體上或精神上。然後，耶穌派遣他們到福傳與牧靈。主要工作，是驅魔和治療：“耶穌召集了那十二人來，賜給他們制伏一切魔鬼，並治療疾病的能力和權柄。”

名詞“力量”（dynamis）表示門徒藉著施行奇蹟而對人釋放的天主力量。“權柄”（exousia）是指門徒的內在力量，這權柄能夠摧毀邪惡。簡言之，門徒們受耶穌的委託，要治癒受傷的世界，擺脫魔鬼的影響。

靈性上死亡的人，因所宣講的福音而復活，並恢復活力。特別是靈性驅魔包括將人從導致犯罪的惡習中解放出來。成為治療者就是要彼此相愛，好讓每個人都能看到天主面容。當基督徒分享耶穌的天主使命時，可以為所接觸的人帶來治療和完整人性。

驅魔意味著讓所有因被邊緣化、拒絕或鄙視的人康復，並完全回歸團體當中。基督徒被召叫，是去愛與治療，讓世界都看見天主面容。

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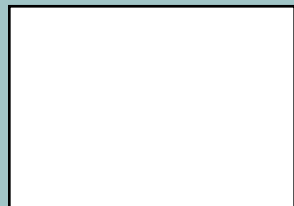
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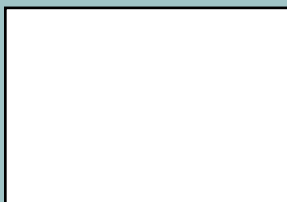
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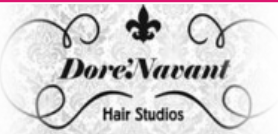


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
