# Successful Brubeck Concert

The Dave Brubeck Pange Lingua Variations concert, held on Saturday, July 6, was a success by every measure – artistically, ecumenically and financially.

The concert, which included other works by Brubeck and works by Dan Forrest, played out to an audience of about 600.

Approximately 90 people attended the wine-and-cheese reception that

preceded the concert. And approximately half of them took advantage of the historical tours of the Cathedral that were offered during the reception.

The concert generated \$41,000 in gross revenue, resulting in a \$5,700 profit contribution to the Cathedral's Social Service Ministries.

**A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥134 (Luke 路10:1-9)**

七十二門徒被派往各城各地去，耶穌預先警告他們，他們會像“羔羊往狼群中”。那麼，他們該如何面對這艱難時期呢？

耶穌教導背後主題，是讓門徒被派遣作活見證，因此除了天主恩賜以外，他們不能依賴任何人事物。

事實上，七十二門徒的工作不是來自人類計劃，因此必需天主力量，天主賦予他們用生命宣揚福音的能力；此外還有根本要求，即門徒甚至要放棄生活必需，好能成為對天主信仰的活見證，又為世界作為天主恩寵的標記。他們脫離物質財富的享受，目的是使他們能堅持宣講福音的絕對優先。他們不要所有生活必需品，因為天主會透過四周聽道的人來細心照顧。“放下一切”這精神也將幫助他們更深信天主恩寵。因此，門徒簡樸生活方式有助於見證他們所傳的福音：“天主的國已經臨近你們了。”

然而，害怕被人拒絕是傳教士主要情緒擔憂之一。耶穌安慰他們說：“那裡如有和平之子，你們的和平就要停留在他身上；否則，仍歸於你們。”

這和平是什麼？“和平”（eirēnē）表示內心的平靜和心靈的祝福，這是任何外在事物都無法比擬的。因此，耶穌強調：人的一切拒絕都不會奪去門徒的內在平安，因這平安源自天主祝福。

忠貞信徒自然吸引他人加入教會，就像玫瑰以其美麗芬芳吸引眼球一樣。構成基督徒生活見證的美麗芬芳，基本要素不是成千上萬的文字，而是現代世界最需要的：對天主的英豪見證。

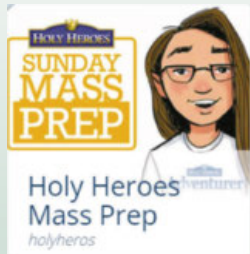
Keep growing in your faith as you take time away from school and work and focus on being together as a family. Here are some ways to stay connected with your faith while enjoying your Summer!

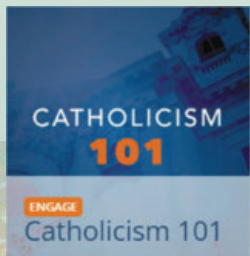

#### Focus of the Gospel:

The Responsorial Psalm next Sunday, we reply, "The Lord gave them bread from heaven." In Exodus we hear the story of manna, the mysterious bread-like substance given to the Israelites while they traveled through the desert. The 40 years in the desert was a preparation time for God's people to learn to trust in their Creator, and ultimately, to be able to hope for the Savior, Jesus. The theme of bread is carried forward in the Gospel with Jesus referring to Himself as "true Bread from heaven." We have come to live the fulfillment of Jesus' words every time we receive Him in the Most Holy Eucharist. It is here that we can find life.

### GOSPEL JN 6:1-15

Jesus went across the Sea of Galilee. A large crowd followed him, because they saw the signs he was performing on the sick. Jesus went up on the mountain, and there he sat down with his disciples. The Jewish feast of Passover was near. When Jesus raised his eyes and saw that a large crowd was coming to him, he said to Philip, "Where can we buy enough food for them to eat?" He said this to test him, because he himself knew what he was going to do. Philip answered him, "Two hundred days' wages worth of food would not be enough for each of them to have a little." One of his disciples, Andrew, the brother of Simon Peter, said to him, "There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish; but what good are these for so many?" Jesus said, "Have the people recline." Now there was a great deal of grass in that place. So the men reclined, about five thousand in number. Then Jesus took the loaves, gave thanks, and distributed them to those who were reclining, and also as much of the fish as they wanted. When they had had their fill, he said to his disciples, "Gather the fragments left over, so that nothing will be wasted." So they collected them, and filled twelve wicker baskets with fragments from the five barley loaves that had been more than they could eat. When the people saw the sign he had done, they said, "This is truly the Prophet, the one who is to come into the world." Since Jesus knew that they were going to come and carry him off to make him king, he withdrew again to the mountain alone.

“Recojan los pedazos sobrantes, para que no se desperdicien”. Los recogieron y con los pedazos que sobraron de los cinco panes llenaron doce canastos.

Entonces la gente, al ver el signo que Jesús había hecho, decía: “Éste es, en verdad, el profeta que habría de venir al mundo”. Pero Jesús, sabiendo que iban a llevárselo para proclamarlo rey, se retiró de nuevo a la montaña, él solo.

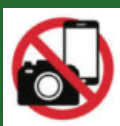

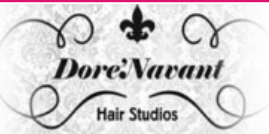
