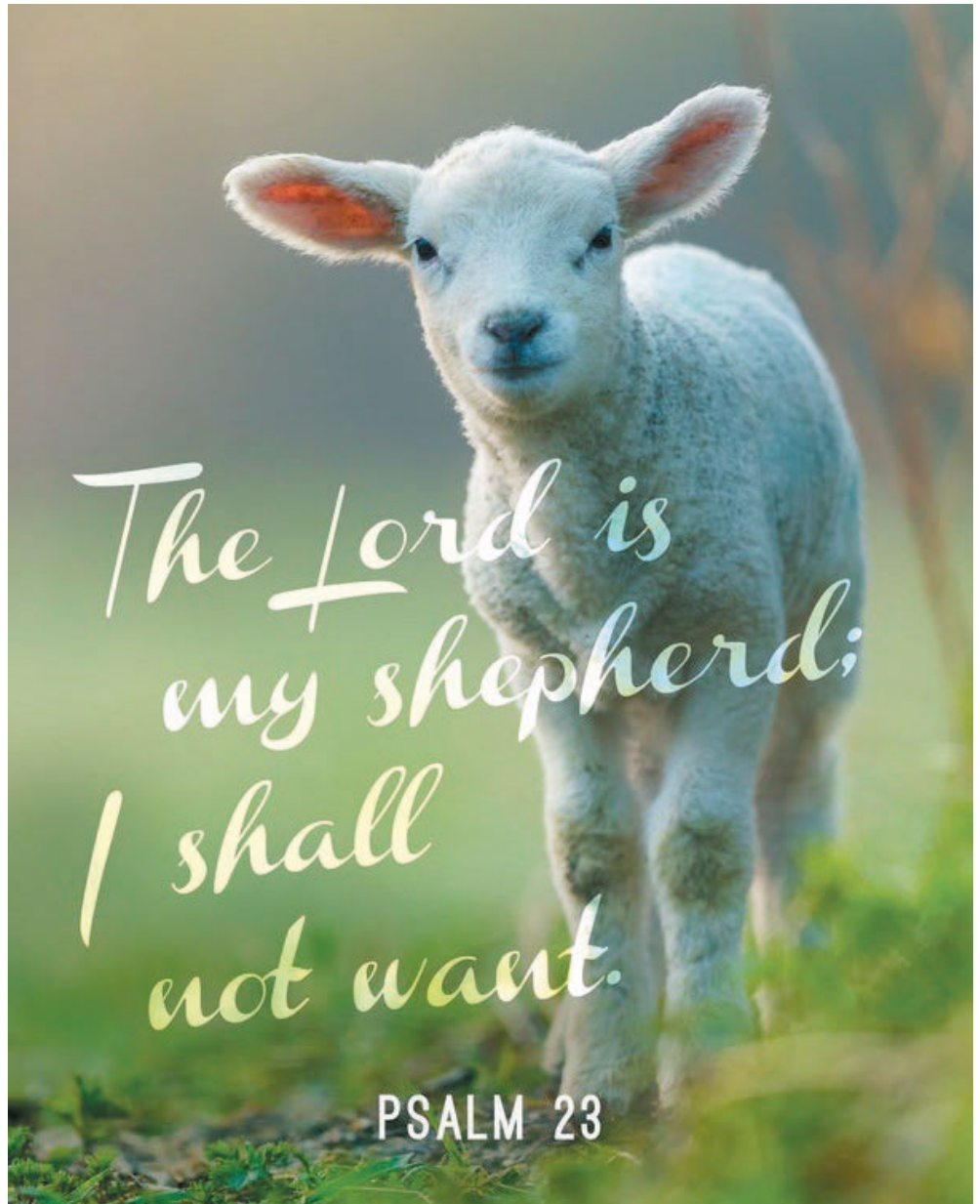

# *Ordination of Bishop Rey Bersabal*



# Ordenación del obispo Rey Bersabal

*Wherever the bishop shall appear, there let the multitude [of the people] also be; even as, wherever Jesus Christ is, there is the Catholic Church. -St Ignatius of Antioch, Epistle to the Smyrnaeans, ca. 110 AD*

On May 31, 2024, something truly extraordinary took place within the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament. With the Episcopal Ordination of Bishop Rey Bersabal, the Catholic Church received a new bishop, a new successor of the apostles themselves.

The celebration was massive, and it was a great joy to have been able to take part. Before the Mass began, Mercy Hall was buzzing with deacons, priests, bishops, and cardinals, all eager to participate in the celebration. There was certainly an air of excitement as so many ordained ministers were packed into the vestibule, with many recognizable faces and personalities present in the procession. Despite the massive scope of our Church, this procession was such a powerful sign of our unity; ordained ministers from different Dioceses, religious orders, and rites walked side-by-side down the aisle in visible communion. Our Cathedral choir, assisted by the St Francis Parish choir, set the tone with joyful voices praising our Lord.

I remember standing near the vestibule of the Cathedral watching this procession occur, in awe at the sheer number and diversity of ministers. Here

were men from all different walks of life, from all over the world, who had said yes to Christ's invitation to serve at His altar. The pews were crammed with people praying, filling the balcony was the live-stream team broadcasting the celebration, at the doors were the ushers welcoming and directing the congregation, and in the hall there were servers preparing the reception; all sorts of people, men and women, who had accepted Christ's invitation to be a member of His living, breathing presence on earth, His Church.

Here Christ was present so powerfully, here in this Cathedral. He met us in His many ministers and in His faithful congregation. He met us in the music joyfully sung, in His words proclaimed in the Gospel, in the Breaking of Bread, and in the ordination of our new bishop.

In a time of such division, here we came together to say, "This is more important than our differences, our opinions, and our preferences." Here Jesus, through the Holy Spirit, gave us a new bishop, a new representative of His love and authority on earth. From the Pope who appointed him to the person watching the live stream at home, we all had a part to play through our ministries, our services, and our prayers, all of us members of Christ's visible Body, the Church.

A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥 133 (Mark 谷 4:35-41)

如果生活中從未出現狂風巨浪，似乎不太可能獲得真正內心平安，同時也不知道耶穌是誰。為什麼？

每當基督徒陷入危險、風浪、疾病或絕望時，他們有時會質疑天主慈悲，甚至懷疑自己是否被天主詛咒。然而，耶穌總是用生活例子來教導我們，而現在，是一場風暴！當狂風巨浪襲擊小船，耶穌在船尾安詳依枕而睡。在暴風雨中不可能睡的那麼沉，這表明是另有目的。目的是什麼？

由於無法控制恐懼，門徒叫醒耶穌，抱怨他無視他們安全。耶穌立即回應，因他關注門徒所面臨的人身危險。耶穌的話“不要作聲，平定了吧！”是命令，說明耶穌有能力戰勝對人身（谷1:21-28）和人心（谷4:35-41）的破壞力量。耶穌的一句話，讓海面瞬間平靜下來。動詞“平定”（pephimōso）表示歸於沉默、馬上閉嘴以及不要發言；耶穌確實把狂風巨浪變成平靜無聲。風浪已經平息，但門徒卻依然非常恐懼，為什麼？

耶穌將門徒從危險中拯救出來，但他們卻認不出拯救他們的那一位是誰。這些門徒雖然被耶穌召叫作為入室弟子，但他們的心仍然放在耶穌奧秘之外。即使在平定風浪奇蹟之後，他們依然非常害怕地問道：“這人到底是誰？連風和海也聽從他！”

耶穌對我們來說，是誰？

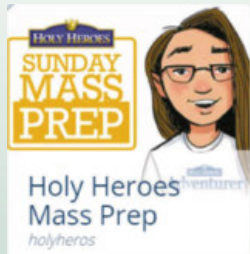

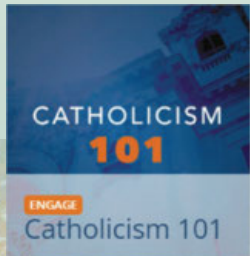

# Formación y Educación en la Fe

### Prepare: 17th Sunday of Ordinary Time

### Focus of the Gospel:

As Jesus became more known in the surrounding villages, people would take their backpack and water bottle and head out to him. They would sometimes walk a couple of hours, or half-day to reach the place where Jesus was. Many people came unprepared with nothing to eat. Jesus could see the hunger in his eyes, and he knew he would feed them, but asks the question to help reinforce the disciples' faith in him. The text says there were 5,000 men (not including women and children). Some scholars estimate maybe 10-17,000—the capacity of the Arena in Sacramento is 17,608? Jesus took five loaves of bread and two fish, and had the disciples feed the many, and none went away hungry, but had plenty left over to send home with them.

### Enfoque del evangelio:

A medida que Jesús se hacía más conocido en los pueblos de los alrededores, la gente cogía su mochila y su cantimplora y se dirigía hacia él. A veces caminaban un par de horas, o medio día, para llegar al lugar donde estaba Jesús. Mucha gente venía desprevenida y sin nada que comer. Jesús podía ver el hambre en sus ojos, y sabía que les daría de comer, pero hace la pregunta para ayudar a reforzar la fe de los discípulos en él. El texto dice que había 5.000 hombres (sin incluir mujeres y niños). Algunos eruditos estiman que tal vez entre 10.000 y 17.000 —la capacidad del estadio de Sacramento es de 17.608? Jesús tomó cinco panes y dos peces, e hizo que los discípulos dieran de comer a muchos, y ninguno se fue con hambre, sino que sobró mucho para enviar a casa.

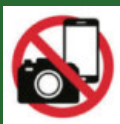

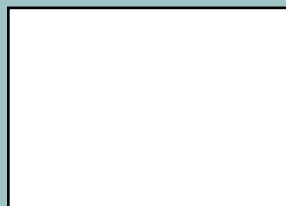
