The Steward’s Work Is Never Done

Woe to the shepherds who mislead and scatter the flock! When you hear these strong words from the Old Testament, you’re probably thinking, thank goodness I don’t have any sheep — dodged that bullet. Nobody misled here! No flock scattered on my watch! However, we are all shepherds of a kind, called to tend our own sheep: our families, our parishes, our communities.

But it’s exhausting. Don’t we all sometimes just want to take a break from being a steward? The excuses are so familiar: we’re tired, we’ve done enough, we’ve given all we can, what more does the parish (or my spouse, or my kids, or my boss, or my friends, or my community) want? We give ourselves permission to be selfish. So, what if the flock scatters just a little?

Jesus gets that. We can just imagine him weary with exhaustion, can’t we? We see him on his boat, attempting to sneak away for a quick break — maybe just a chance to eat a bite of food in peace. He is God, but he was still human, after all. Even the most dedicated shepherds need to sleep. But people couldn’t leave him alone. They were hungry for him. They needed what he could offer, and they needed it now.

As tough as it is, that’s the example we are tasked with imitating. Everyday Stewardship demands accountability. It demands our showing up even when we are tired. It demands that we look at our lives, our time, our energies, our talents, our hearts, our bank accounts and think: where do I still have more to give?

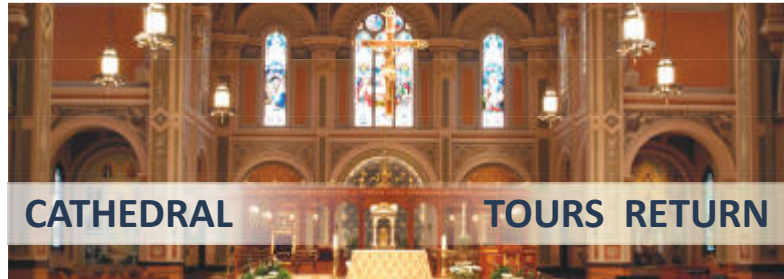

Today in our Gospel we hear how excited the Apostles are as they preach to the people the Gospel message. Many people are listening to them and

accepting something of what Jesus has come to offer. It is a beautiful image in which the gift that Jesus brings through his Apostles is being appreciated and valued. Throughout this excitement, however, is the awareness of still how many more people are lost and in need of Jesus. As the Apostles spread the Good News, they will be challenged by the reality that many who came to Jesus will also walk away and not embrace a life with Him. People will choose to remain in the darkness and be lost.

Of course, the gift of Jesus is still being offered today. As well, many people still look as though they are sheep without a shepherd. We in the Church can offer the gift of Jesus and be excited by the number of people who respond to the words of the gospel. We are also challenged by the reality that many people will choose to remain in the darkness. This aspect of Church life in which we look at the numbers and gauge our ministry through a somewhat “economic” lens is very risky. In the Church today, we often view the free gift of Jesus as a product to be packaged so that people will “buy” it over all the other products out there. We form strategies that appeal to differing groups to encourage higher numbers of consumers. The more people in our pews, at our retreats, serving in ministry, learning Latin, and giving financial support, the more excited we will discuss the great things that are going on, just like the Apostles did. None of this, however, means people are embracing Jesus.

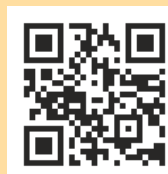
The message of Jesus is not a product to be sold or even to be given away freely. It is not a product at all. For Jesus to be a “product” would imply that other products have their value, but our product of Jesus is the best.

Exciting but wrong. Jesus and His message are not in the same category as other “helps” in our society. He is not a product or a way of life or a life choice. He is. He is Life. He is the only choice. No numbers will ever change this truth. We simply must be aware of and preach this simple truth. It is not a truth that appeals to people’s lusts or appetites or egos. We may approach Jesus in the hopes of getting something from Him, but the true value of His gift comes only when we let go of the need for anything and live in Him.

Hoy en nuestro Evangelio escuchamos lo entusiasmado que están los Apóstoles al predicar a la gente el mensaje del Evangelio. Mucha gente los escucha y acepta algo de lo que Jesús tiene y viene a ofrecernos. Es una imagen hermosa en la cual se refleja el don que Jesús trae a través de sus Apóstoles, el ser apreciado y valorado. Sin embargo, a lo largo de este entusiasmo cuántas personas todavía están perdidas de su conciencia y necesitadas de Jesús. A medida que los Apóstoles difunden las Buenas Nuevas, serán desafiados por la realidad de que muchos de los que vinieron a Jesús también se irán y no abrazarán una vida con Él. La gente optará por permanecer en la oscuridad y perderse.

Por supuesto, el regalo de Jesús todavía se ofrece hoy. Además, muchas personas todavía andan como ovejas sin pastor. Nosotros en la Iglesia podemos ofrecer el don de Jesús y estar entusiasmados por la cantidad de personas que responden a las palabras del evangelio. Nosotros también estaremos desafiados por la realidad de que muchas personas optarán por permanecer en la oscuridad. En este aspecto de vida de la iglesia en la que miramos a números y evaluamos nuestros ministerios a través de una mirada “económica” es muy riesgoso. En la Iglesia de hoy, a menudo vemos el don gratuito de Jesús como un producto de empaque para que la gente lo “compre” sobre todo los demás productos que existen. Nosotros formamos estrategias que atraen a los diferentes grupos para alentar a un mayor número de consumidores. Entre más personas hay en nuestras bancas, en nuestros retiros, sirviendo en los ministerios, aprendiendo latín y dando apoyo financiero, estaremos nosotros más entusiasmados a discutir las grandes cosas que están sucediendo en nuestra iglesia, al igual como los Apóstoles lo hicieron. Sin embargo, nada de esto significa que la gente está abrazando a Jesús.

El mensaje de Jesús no es un producto para vender o incluso regalar gratuitamente. No es un producto en absoluto. Que Jesús sea un "producto" implicaría que otros productos tienen su valor, pero nuestro producto de Jesús es el mejor. Emocionante pero equivocado. Jesús y su mensaje no son la misma categoría como otras “ayudas” en nuestra sociedad. No es un producto, una forma de vida o una elección de vida. Él es. Él es vida. Él es la única opción. Ningún número cambiará jamás esta verdad. Simplemente debemos ser conscientes y predicar esta simple verdad. No es una verdad que atraiga a los placeres mundanos o el ego de las personas. Podemos acercarnos a Jesús con la esperanza de obtener algo de Él, pero el verdadero valor de su regalo viene solo cuando dejamos ir la necesidad de cualquier cosa y vivimos en Él.

What does a Disciple look like? ¿Cómo se ve un discípulo?

This past week on Relevant Radio's *The Inner Life*, host Josh Raymond recounted the time he auditioned to be the new keyboardist for a band years ago. After he and some of the other members arrived, the last person to show up for the audition was the lead guitarist. When he finally arrived, he descended the stairs to the basement looking exactly like the guitarist from Guns 'N' Roses, Slash. The only missing piece was the top hat. Josh could immediately tell that his main musical influence must be Slash. And as he later disclosed, he was Slash's biggest fan.

Josh likened this anecdote to the way that we should be as disciples of Christ. "And I don't mean that we should all wear our hair long and grow beards and put on sandals. But if someone encountered you for the first time, just like when I very first met that guitar player and knew without him saying a word that he was a Slash devotee, would somebody meeting you for the first time know that you were a disciple of Jesus?" Summer of Faith: The Creed—Week 2 is.gd/summerlesson Verano de Fe: el credo - Semana 2

We are Created in the Image of God, but fallen from Grace. “Then the LORD God formed man of dust from the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being” (Genesis 2:7). As this verse from Scripture shows us, man is created with both a body and a spirit. “The human body shares in the dignity of the ‘image of God’” (CCC 364). Man is the only part of God’s creation that shares in both the material and spiritual order. Animals do not have immortal souls and cannot reason, choose freely, and love as we can. Angels, on the other hand, are pure created spirits. They have no bodies. Man was also uniquely created in a state of Original Holiness and Original Justice. God gave Adam and Eve all the knowledge that they would need, and their wills did not tend to sin. They were God’s friends, and they shared in His divine life. In other words, they were filled with grace. Grace is the life of God in our soul. It is a free gift from God, and it is necessary for anyone to live eternally with Him in Heaven. Adam and Eve’s original state of grace is called Original Holiness. Their fall from Grace in their disobedience is known as Original Sin ... even then, God promised a way back to Himself through the covenants.

El hombre es la única parte de la creación de Dios que comparte tanto el orden material como el espiritual. Los animales no tienen almas inmortales y no pueden razonar, elegir libremente y amar como podemos. Los ángeles, por otro lado, son espíritus creados puros. No tienen cuerpos. El hombre también fue creado de forma única en un estado de Santidad Original y Justicia Original. Dios les dio a Adán y Eva todo el conocimiento que necesitarían, y sus voluntades no tendieron a pecar. Eran amigos de Dios y compartían Su vida divina. En otras palabras, estaban llenos de gracia. La gracia es la vida de Dios en nuestra alma. Es un regalo gratuito de Dios y es necesario que cualquier persona viva eternamente con Él en el Cielo. El estado de gracia original de Adán y Eva se llama Santidad Original. Su caída de la gracia en su desobediencia se conoce como pecado original ... incluso entonces, Dios prometió un camino de regreso a sí mismo a través de los pactos.

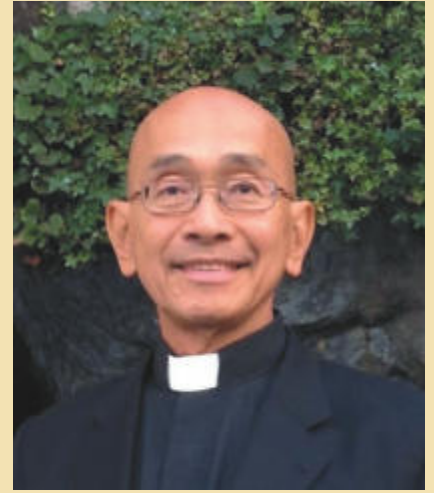

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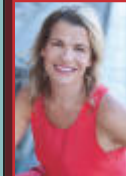
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
