STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

ur readings today remind us of the great privilege we have in calling ourselves both children and disciples of the Most High God.

The First Reading from Isaiah describes a vision of the prophet in which angels surround the Lord proclaiming, "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts! All the earth is filled with his glory!" Our God invites us to such deep intimacy and friendship with Him that sometimes we can forget just how majestic and unspeakably holy He truly is.

In the Gospel passage, from Luke, Jesus instructs Simon to lower his nets for a catch despite an unsuccessful night of fishing. Peter is skeptical but obeys and is amazed at the catch of fish that he makes. He kneels down before Jesus in astonishment.

This sense of awe and reverence before God should motivate us to deepen our stewardship way of life. As we contemplate the holiness of God, we come to a heightened awareness of what a privilege it is that He has chosen to include us in His work of spreading the Gospel to others through the grateful sharing of the gifts He has given us. Aware of this privilege, we will then make the words of Isaiah our own:

"Here I am Lord, send me!"


Saint of the Week

Saint Josephine Bakhita (1869-1947) was born in the Darfur region of Sudan. She was kidnapped at the age of 8 and sold into slavery many times. As she passed from owner to owner, she experienced the moral and physical humiliations associated with slavery. After twelve years as a slave, she was brought to Italy by the Italian Consul in Sudan. Up until then she had known her masters to be cruel and violent. but at last she was treated with kindness and respect. She was left in the care of the Canossian Sisters, and as Italy had no slave laws, she found freedom. She was baptized and confirmed in the Catholic Church in 1890, and took the name Josephine. Three years later she entered the Canossian Sisters. For the last 50 years she lived in the Canossian Convent in Schio, Italy, where she cooked, sewed, did housekeeping. By her smile and gentle nature many people came to love God.



Who are the "fishers of men" today? Priests! They help people to come to the Faith by giving them the sacraments and teaching them the truth about God.



A Glimpse of Spirituality (靈修一瞥) 9

"The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent, and believe in the gospel."

The Chinese New Year celebration is not limited to "Kung Hei Fat Choy" but renewal of life as a new start of another year. Repentance signifies the renewal of faith no matter how wicked the previous year was.

The verb "repent" in Greek (metanoeo) means to change one's mind or direction. Repentance means that we make a complete change of direction. This involves a radical conversion, a change of direction and priorities in our lives.

For Jesus, repentance is not merely saying "I am sorry," but also promising "I will change my life." Real repentance means that a person has come, not only to be sorry for the consequences of his/her sin, but to hate sin itself.

People often think of repentance as feeling guilty, but it is more than that. Once we begin to see things correctly, it might follow that we will feel bad about having seen them wrongly for so long, like St Augustine after his conversion.

Indeed, repentance starts with the new vision rather than the guilt feelings. By true repentance people are inviting God to do what they cannot do themselves – namely, to raise the dead self to the resurrected self.

Additionally, "repent" here is used in the present tense that means "keep on repenting" and "continually be repentant." Repentance must be the ongoing life of the people toward the kingdom of God, with end and without end.

"悔改"(metanoeo)解作改變個人想法或方向,意味著徹底改變生活方向,即徹底轉變。

對耶穌來說,悔改不只是"對不起"或"不好意思",而是對自己定志說: "我會改變我的生活"。

真正悔改不僅要為犯罪後果感到抱歉,而且還要憎恨罪惡本身。

人經常認為悔改只不過是內疚,不僅如此,是思想或方向的改變。比方,從奢侈到神貧,由嫉妒到欣賞,或從驕傲 到謙虛。

事實上,悔改始於積極面對將來,懷有新的願景,而不只顧內疚。通過真正悔改,神蹟就會發生在罪人身上,就是 死去的舊我複活,成為永恆的人。罪人悔改,比任何起死回生神蹟都偉大;起死回生,還會再死,罪人悔改,永 生。

還有,這裡"悔改"用了現在時態,意思是"不斷悔改"和"不斷的被修和"。是天國子民一輩子的生活態度。 悔改,有多難?只在願不願意
