



- RCIA is a process of study, exploration, faith-sharing, and faith formation with specific liturgical rites for seekers and inquirers. Seekers and inquirers are non-baptized adults who desire to be fully initiated into the Roman Catholic Church and/or baptized adult Christians who desire full communion in the Roman Catholic Church.



## JESUS REMINDS US THAT WE ARE BRANCHES CONNECTED TO HIM, THE VINE

Jesus today reminds us that we are branches connected to Him, the vine. This relationship helps us to understand that without being connected to Jesus, we will not be able to survive. Without being connected to Jesus, we will not be able to bear fruit. This image of vine and branches clarifies what may be at the root of many of our own issues, both in the big picture of society as well as in our personal lives. It seems that most of the time people are living as separate branches from the vine. For those who do not believe in Jesus, they can find themselves feeling lost and alone. Not being connected to the vine can lead to a continual struggle for things without finding any real meaning in life.

However, for those who believe in Jesus, there can still exist a great sense of loneliness and loss. This is due to living in a relationship in which we see ourselves as the vine and Jesus as a branch. Jesus is just one part of my life which helps me to bear the fruit that I want. I freely confess my faith in Jesus, but deep down I know that the fruit I bear is often tasteless. Even worse, because I say I believe in Jesus, I become disappointed that Jesus isn't making my life the way I want it to be.

To bear good fruit, I must accept that I am only one branch on the true Vine that is Jesus. The fruit that I bear is meant to reveal the beauty of the vine, not its branches. As believers in Jesus, we take the gifts He has given us and use them to make more visible His presence in the world. True happiness, true peace comes from accepting that God's presence in our lives impels us to work for Him rather than for Him to work for us. Once we strive to live the life of a branch for Jesus, He will beautifully make sure that the fruit we bear will be pleasing to our taste as well as His.

LESSON SUMMARY

I BELIEVE

In this last lesson of the year, we move quickly through the final three articles of the Creed. All of these truths have already been examined in other lessons, and here we explore them in a bit more depth. They are:

- **Forgiveness of Sins**  
 God forgives sin through the sacraments of Baptism, Penance and Reconciliation, and others, especially the Eucharist.
- **Resurrection of the Body**  
 On the Last Day, Christ will raise the bodies of all people from the dead and reunite them with their souls.
- **Life everlasting**  
 This is the closing article of the Creed. It is also the opening of the door to our spiritual life. The Sacred Scriptures tell us that our eternal life begins at Baptism (Romans 6:4). Therefore, our eternal begins here on earth.

Lastly, "**Amen**" The word amen comes from the same Hebrew root as *believe*.


Branching Out Isn't Always What It's Cracked Up to Be

"That's a really beautiful tree branch. Man, would you look at the bark on that thing? The others are real duds, but that low-hanging branch has really got it all together."

I've never heard anyone say this. Maybe I just need to hang out with more arborists, but I can't recall ever hearing someone admire the particular beauty of a single branch. When someone comments on a tree, it's usually the whole tree — perhaps a visual element of it, like the color of the leaves or its height. But people don't usually zero in on one branch. Maybe that's because usually, if one branch is looking a little weak, chances are every other branch is, too.

The Bible tells us that when we bear fruit as good everyday stewards, it is for the Father's glory. We are the branch on His magnificent tree. What we have is from Him, and what we do likewise points back to Him. We also tend to reflect on how well the other branches around us are incorporating the nutrients coming their way. That's all fine and good in theory. In practice, it can be an arduous exercise in humility.

When I do something virtuous or charitable or kind, there is a part of me that wants to stand out for it. I think that's true for all of us. We've given of ourselves in some way or overcome some human temptation to accomplish a little bit of good in this world, and even though we know God sees us, we'd really love for everyone else to see it, too. It's a struggle, for sure. But we need to remember that our fruit belongs to the whole tree.

那棵樹的枝椏真是美麗。夥伴，你會因此想去看一看那樹皮嗎？那樹木其他的部份真的也沒甚麼好看，但那低垂美麗的枝椏，確實也是同一棵大樹所分出的。

也許我需要和更多的樹藝師待再一起。我從沒有聽人這樣說，也不記得會有人這樣評論，只是去欣賞一棵樹的特別單一分枝，通常是評論一整棵樹。應該是樹的視覺元素，例如葉子的顏色，或樹的高度，人們通常不會只有專門看待一枝樹幹，這是在一般的情況下，當一棵樹的分枝看起來有些枯萎時，其他的分枝可能也是有同樣的情形了。

聖經告訴我們，當我們善度每一天，而讓每天都能結出生活的果實來，這是為了光榮天主。我們是祂宏偉大樹上的分枝，我們所有的分枝都是從祂而來，而我們的所作所為也同樣歸回到祂。從理論上來說這都是對的，也都是好的，我們也都顯示出在我們和周圍的分枝上，是如何很好的一起整

合汲取養分。但在實際上，對所有的分枝來說，這可是艱難和需要謙卑練習的行動。

當我做了些善良慈善的事情時，我本身某些部份就會脫穎而出，我認為對我們所有人來說都是如此，我們已經以某種方式付出了自己，或是克服了某些對於人性的誘惑，而在這個世界上做了一點好事。即使我們知道上主已經看到了，但我們也還是非常希望被其他所有的人看到，當然這真是糾結，因此我們必要記住，我們的果實是屬於這整棵大樹的。




