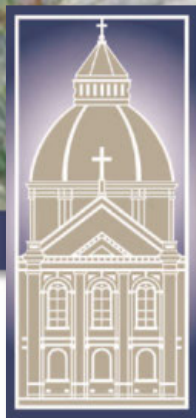

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

How do I know if the Time, Talent and Treasure I offer God in grateful return is “enough?” What is the measure?

St. Paul tells us in the Second Reading today — the “measure” is the love that we put into each of these aspects of our lives. “If I have all faith so as to move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. If I give away everything I own and hand my body over so that I may boast but do not have love, I gain nothing.” God is not after a particular number. What He wants us to give over to Him is our very selves.

Real love is not a sentiment. Real love is manifested in living a virtuous life. We read later in St. Paul’s letter that real love takes strength: it is patient, kind, humble, other-centered, truth-seeking, and long-suffering. Love is the heroic giving of oneself even when it is uncomfortable; especially then. Love looks like Jesus. It lives like Jesus.

Sometimes, living like Jesus is difficult. We see this in the Gospel Reading today where we find Jesus in action, preaching in the synagogue in His hometown. He speaks truth to the people He loves, the ones He grew up with and shared His early days with. How do they respond? They are filled with fury and run Him out of town, intent on throwing Him from a cliff! Yet Jesus is undeterred. He passes right through them and presses forward with the mission His Father has entrusted to Him. We are called to live with this same strength and determination, fueled by the power of love and by gratitude for all God has given us.

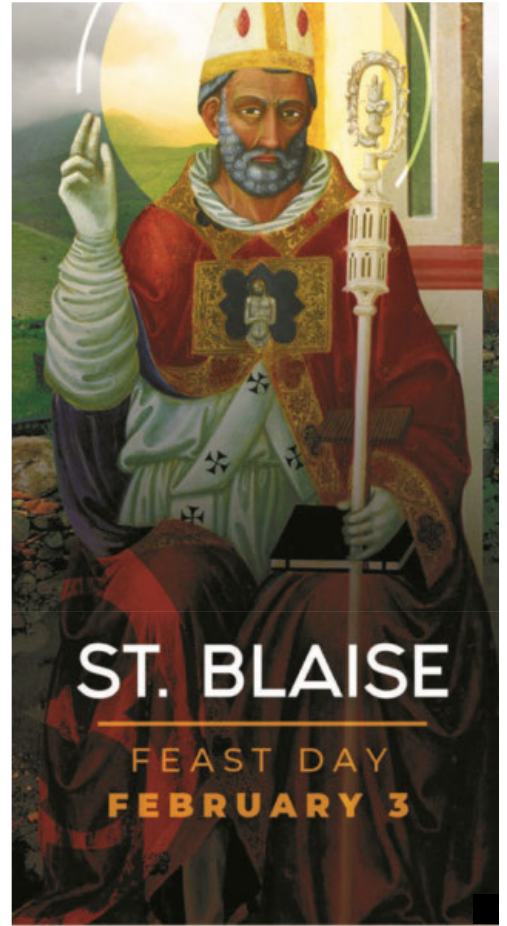

SAINT OF THE WEEK

You may be familiar with the annual “blessing of throats” that many parishes in the United States use to commemorate the beloved bishop and martyr. St. Blaise lived in the fourth century in Turkey and Armenia. Due to religious persecution, he was forced to flee and hide in a cave in the back country in order to save his life.

History has it that one day a group of hunters stumbled upon where St. Blaise was living. They found the bishop kneeling in prayer, surrounded by wolves, lions and bears that he had tamed. The legend has it that as the hunters dragged Blaise off to prison, a mother came with her young son who had a fish bone lodged in his throat. At Blaise’s command, the child was able to cough up the bone and thus lived.

Today we remember the saint on his feast day by taking two candles, crossing them against the throat, and saying the following prayer:

Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from ailments of the throat and from every other evil. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.



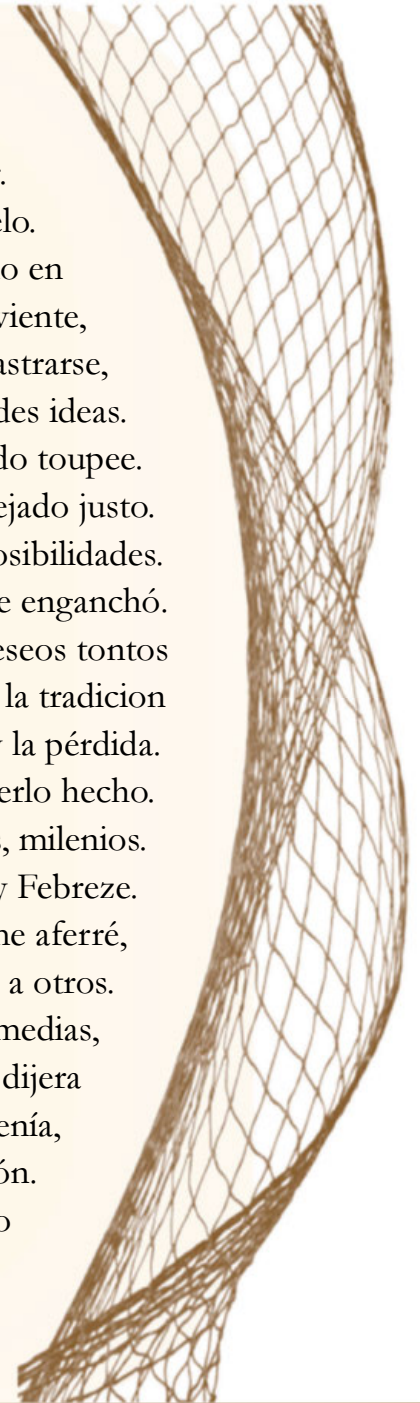

Saint Paul Teaches About Love

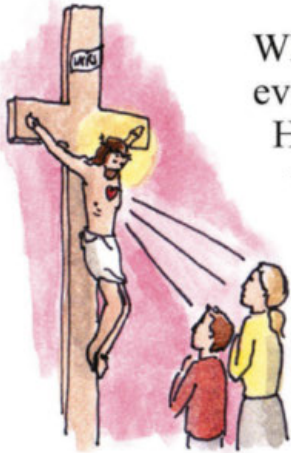
SORRY I BROKE THIS. I FORGIVE YOU.

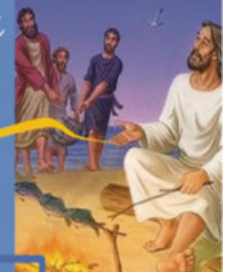

A Glimpse of Spirituality (靈修一瞥) 8

Jesus is not a popular idol but a sign of contradiction. His presence is already the discernment within the people Israel, so that some fall and some rise. Jesus' ministry shows us that even he wants to bring the scattered into God's family, some will reject his invitation because for them, Jesus will not be a hope of promise fulfilled, but a figure that is to be opposed as Simeon says: "Behold, this child is set for the fall and rising of many in Israel, and for a sign that is spoken against."

Actually, Jesus is not a divider. The purpose of his ministry that divides is so that the thoughts of the hearts might be made manifest. In fact, those who fall (ptōsin) because of Jesus will bring upon themselves ruin, i. e. the loss of salvation that is their utter misery.

Jesus is like a rock, whoever climbs up on him will reach heaven ultimately. To the contrast, those who reject this rock by kicking on it will go to their final dwelling place, i.e. hell.

How humans respond to God's promise is made evident by how they respond to Jesus, whose presence reveals their true colors. Jesus comes, humans choose. Some oppose him and fall. Indeed, whoever accepts Jesus is accepted into God's family, the eternal family.

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS - First Corinthians and the Stewardship of Social Media

"Love is patient, love is kind ..." As familiar as these words are, they never seem to stray into the territory of becoming trite or silly. At their core they communicate a truth about us and about our Creator that never fails to inspire.

But despite the fact that you've probably heard it at many weddings over time, First Corinthians isn't just for newlyweds. It wasn't written for married folks. It's for every single one of us, in every state of life and every social situation, in every country and culture and language across the globe.

Which means that First Corinthians is even for the online world. It's for Facebook and Twitter and Instagram and all the other platforms I'm forgetting (there seems to be a new one every day, doesn't there?). A sense of division — whether rooted in politics, culture or anything else — is growing in our world, and it's never more obvious than when we observe interactions online. It is far easier, after all, to remember what love is when a human being of flesh and blood stands before us. When all we see is an avatar or a profile picture on a screen — especially accompanied by an opinion with which we vehemently disagree — even the most loving Christians can throw First Corinthians out the window.

As everyday stewards we know that we are charged to be not only gracious but grateful. We receive others but we also give thanks for what they bring to us — even if that's an opportunity to "strive eagerly for the greatest spiritual gifts."

So before the next time you post anything online, I suggest giving First Corinthians a read — and remember, love never fails.

- 格林多人前書和社交媒體天主僕人的工作

"愛是含忍的，愛是慈祥的。..." 這是句耳熟能詳的話，它似乎從不落入陳腔濫調掉或愚蠢境界之中，這話主要的重心是，傳達了關於我們和我們的造物主的真理，而這個真理永遠不會失去激發靈感。

但是，儘管事實上你可能已經在許多婚禮上聽說過它，格林多人前書的這些話不僅僅只適用於新婚夫婦，也不是僅為已婚夫婦所寫，是為我們每一個人，每種生活狀態，每種社會情況，每一個國家文化和語言所寫的。

這意味著格林多人前書甚至是用於網路世界。它適用於臉書、推特和 IG 以及我所忘記的所有其他平台，(似乎每天都有個新的平台，不是嗎?) 一個分裂感 - 無論是根植於政治、文化還是其它任何事物 - 在我們的世界中日益增長，這永遠不會比我們在網路上觀察互動時更明顯了。畢竟，當一位有血有肉的人站在面前時，要去記住甚麼是愛要容易得多。當我們在螢幕上看到的只是阿凡達個人頭像時 - 特別是我們伴隨著強烈的反對意識時，就算是最有愛心的基督徒也會把格林多人前書扔出窗外。

作為僕人，我們知道，我們不僅要親切還要感恩。我們接納他人，但也要心存感恩他們所帶給我們的東西 - 即使這是一個 "熱切爭取最偉大屬於神的恩寵" 的機會。

因此，下次你在網上發布任何貼文之前，我建議先讀一讀格林多人前書 - 記住，愛永恆不朽。
