LETS TALK PARISH

The pandemic forced many parishes to connect via the internet. The Cathedral's live stream ministry was one of our lockdown success stories, so successful that they were featured in The Catholic Herald Magazine.

What were other ways we could connect our parishioners on a personal level? Last Fall, I had the idea of starting a parish podcast as a way for our parishioners to share their faith and how the Cathedral has been instrumental in that journey. Thus, we created **Let's Talk Parish!**

I spoke with Titi Kila, head of the live stream ministry, and we thought that parishioner Chris Jensen would act as a good host as Chris was already producing his own personal podcast. Chris was excited to join this endeavor, and he currently acts as host and producer.

The audio-only podcast has proven to be an effective medium in sharing our parishioners' stories. We are nearing 2000 "views," and the analytics reveal an average listen time of 100% of the entire episode length. With 17, 1-hour episodes, this equates to 34,000 hours of engagement thus far! Contrast this to an average YouTube video, where a viewer normally watches only a couple minutes of a video.

Our most popular episodes so far include our rector, Fr. O'Reilly, and sacristan, Michael Ognisty. Newly uploaded episodes include Sr. Lisa Marie Doty, Director of Faith Formation; Joseph Martinez, parish council member; Rachel Songer, cantor; Anthony Simene, altar server/master of ceremonies. Our hope is that your faith is enriched by hearing one another's faith journeys.

You can catch Let's Talk Parish on Anchor.fm and other podcasting sites, such as Apple Podcasts, iHeart Radio, and Google Podcasts. Subscribe to the podcast to be automatically notified of new episodes, which are uploaded every other Saturday morning.





Prayer for the Success of our Cathedral Retreat

O most beautiful Flower of Mount Carmel, Fruitful Vine, Splendour of Heaven, Blessed Mother of the Son of God, Immaculate Virgin, assist us in this our necessity. O Star of the Sea, help us and show us herein you are our Mother.

O Holy Mary, Mother of God, Queen of Heaven and Earth, We humbly beseech you from the bottom of our hearts, to help us in this necessity (the success of our Cathedral retreat); there are none that can withstand your power.

O, show us herein you are our Mother, O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee. (3 times)

Sweet Mother, I place this cause in your hands. (3 times)

We hear in the Gospel reading that the Apostles first preached a message of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. That same message is still preached today but is probably not the most common message preached in Catholic churches. Of course, there are many topics and lessons for us “preachers” to offer, such as prayer, the love of God, service to neighbor, etc... but perhaps these messages are lost if we don’t really live the message to repent and be forgiven of our sins.

To recognize that I am a sinner, that my sins are stunting me and damaging the lives around me, that they spread their own message of un-belief, selfishness, and darkness,

To see that my individual world is much greater when viewed in the context of the embrace of my heavenly Father and the love of my brothers and sisters;

To accept the hidden loneliness that comes from failure to admit I sin, I am wrong, I need help, I’m not perfect, I hurt others, I’m not my own god;

To desire the need to repent and feel the release of all these burdens and experience the forgiveness of the One who can truly say “let it go” and “sin no more”;

this is still a message we need to hear today and every day. If we understood our need to bow down in contrition and admit our hubris, we would sense the great expulsion of all our unclean spirits.

This type of repentance is more than the list of sins many of us bring to the confessional. Most of the sins brought to confession are symptoms of the greater sin of not believing, not believing that God cares and not believing that God owns me, His servant. Every sin is a deliberate choice to tell God that I am in charge of my life and every sin pulls me further into the caresses of unclean spirits. This is why all the other beautiful messages from Jesus get distorted by the darkness of sin which surrounds our lives. The message of repentance for the forgiveness of sins is still the first message we must hear and take to heart.

Escuchamos en la lectura del Evangelio que los Apóstoles predicaron primero un mensaje de arrepentimiento para el perdón de los pecados. Ese mismo mensaje todavía se predica hoy, pero probablemente no sea el mensaje más común que se predica en las iglesias católicas. Por supuesto que hay muchos temas y lecciones que ofrecemos como "predicadores", como la oración, el amor de Dios, el servicio a los demás, etc. ... pero quizás estos mensajes se pierdan si no vivimos realmente el mensaje de arrepentimiento y ser perdonados de nuestros pecados.

Reconocer que soy un pecador, que mis pecados me impiden y dañan las vidas a mi alrededor, que difunden su propio mensaje de incredulidad, egoísmo y tinieblas;

Ver que mi mundo individual es mucho más grande cuando se ve en el contexto del abrazo de mi Padre celestial y el amor de mis hermanos y hermanas;

Aceptar la soledad oculta que proviene de no admitir que soy un pecador, que me equivoco, que necesito ayuda, que no soy perfecto, que lastimó a los demás, que no soy mi propio dios;

Desear la necesidad de arrepentirse y sentir la liberación de todas estas cargas y experimentar el perdón de Aquel que verdaderamente puede decir "déjalo ir" y "no peques más";

todavía es un mensaje que debemos escuchar hoy y todos los días. Si entendiéramos nuestra necesidad de inclinarnos en contrición y admitir nuestra arrogancia, sentiríamos la gran expulsión de todos nuestros espíritus inmundos.

Este tipo de arrepentimiento es más que la lista de pecados que muchos de nosotros llevamos al confesionario. La mayoría de los pecados que se llevan a la confesión son síntomas del mayor pecado de no creer, no creer que Dios se preocupa y no creer que Dios me pertenece a mí, Su siervo. Cada pecado es una elección deliberada para decirle a Dios que estoy a cargo de mi vida y cada pecado me empuja más hacia las caricias de los espíritus inmundos. Es por eso que todos los otros hermosos mensajes de Jesús están distorsionados por la oscuridad del pecado que envuelve nuestras vidas. El mensaje de arrepentimiento para el perdón de los pecados sigue siendo el primer mensaje que debemos escuchar y tomar en serio.

I believe ... Our Creed begins with these words. But what does it mean to “believe”? To “believe” means:

- To accept as the truth.
- To expect or hope for with confidence.
- To have trust.
- To have faith.

Faith is a gift from God, as well as our free response to believe what God tells us about Himself and about the world He created. We first receive the gift of faith in the Sacrament of Baptism. Our faith is then strengthened through the other Sacraments. Jesus tells us many times, and the Catholic Church teaches that “*Believing in Jesus Christ and in the One who sent him for our salvation is necessary for obtaining that salvation*” (CCC 161). God helps us to believe by revealing Himself to us in three ways: reason, Divine Revelation and through God’s creation. EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS - What We Carry from Town to Town

In my experience, there are two kinds of people: the folks who kick off their shoes the second they walk through the door, and the ones who don't. People can feel strongly about this on both sides. The main thrust of the Shoes-Off Brigade seems to be this: we track a lot of weird stuff on the soles of our feet. Little reminders of all the places we've been — whether it's a private home or a public bathroom — cling to our shoes long after we leave.

This same theory applies to our spiritual lives. As human beings and as disciples, we visit a lot of figurative towns and pick up a lot of figurative dust. Sinfulness. Shame. Defeat. Anger. Fear. Doubt. No matter how hard we try to keep free of it, these things have a way of attaching themselves to us, sometimes without us even noticing. We need to take a good look at what unhelpful and unconstructive baggage from our past we're tracking into our present and future encounters.

What is the "town" God is asking you to visit today in His name? Is it a tough conversation with a friend, a brief witness to a stranger in the checkout line, a call to be present to someone in your family? Before you go, remember, shake off the dust. Don't let a past disappointment constrain you. Don't allow yesterday's failures or burdens to keep you from the joy of today's witness, whatever form it might take.
