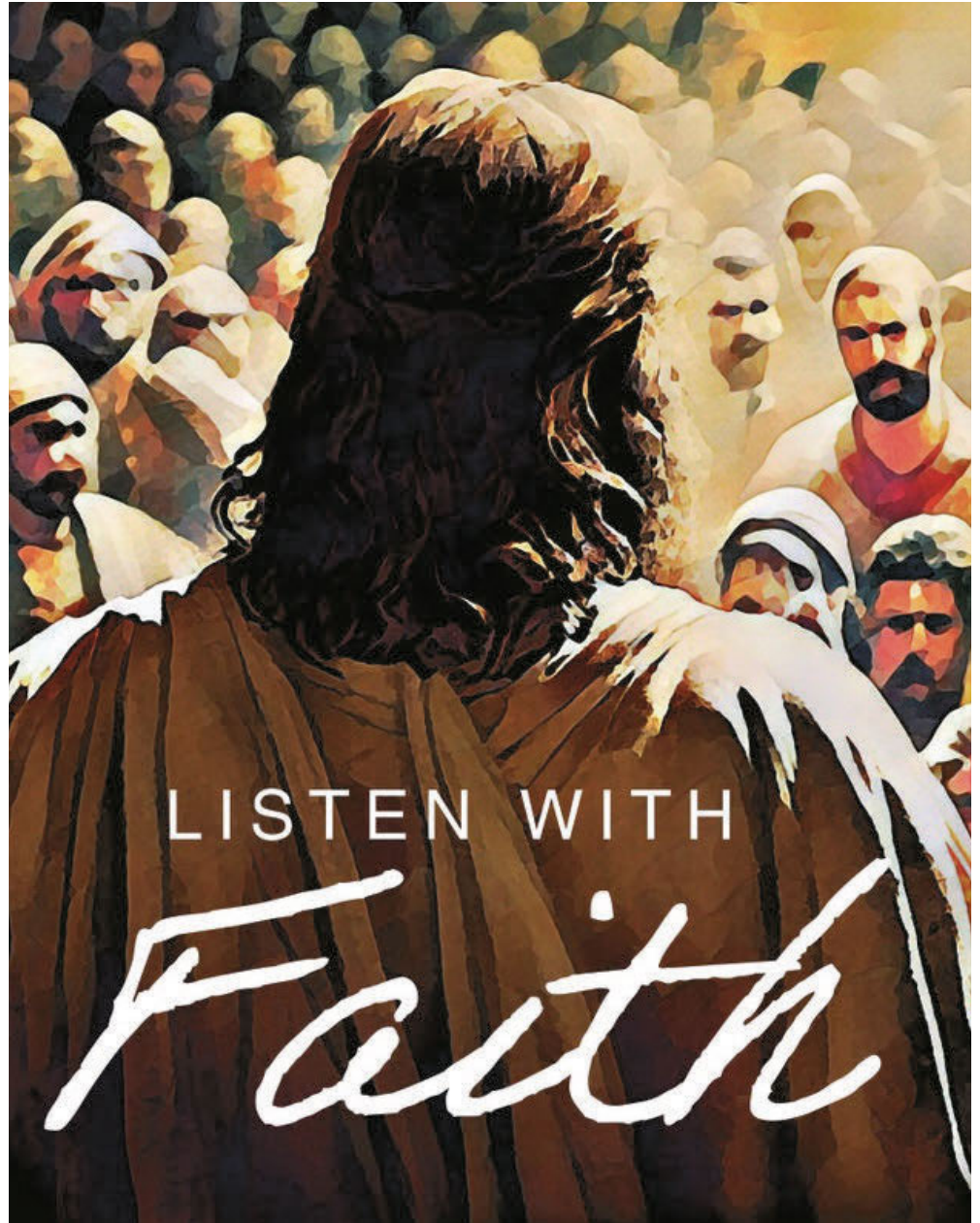

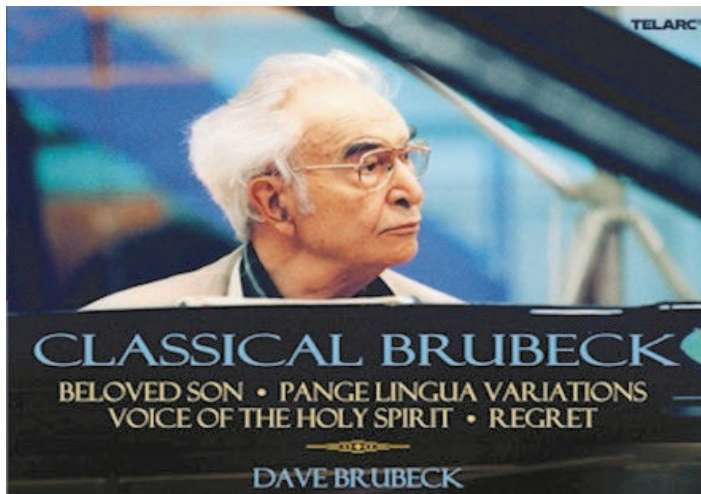

In 1983 the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament commissioned legendary musician Dave Brubeck to compose a variation of the Thomas Aquinas hymn "Pange Lingua, Gloriosi" ("Sing, My Tongue, the Savior's Glory"). The work beautifully captures the poetic spirit of the original Gregorian chant



combined with jazz interludes. It was Brubeck's first sacred composition since he had converted to Catholicism. The Dave Brubeck Quartet first performed the work in the Cathedral with orchestra and chorus over two nights in May 1983 to sell-out audiences.

On July 6 the Emmy-nominated Chris Brubeck Trio (Dave's sons) will join the Cathedral Choir and Orchestra to recreate this beautiful work in a Eucharistic Revival Concert. Tickets are now on sale at <https://cbssac.ticketspice.com/brubeck>. Ticket prices range from \$25 to \$75. A wine-and-cheese reception will precede the concert at a cost of \$50.



# *Eucharistic Pilgrimage*



On Wednesday May 22, close to a 1,000 faithful participated in the Eucharistic Pilgrimage and walked with Bishop Soto from West Sacramento to the Cathedral to honor the Eucharist. The procession ended at the Cathedral plaza with Bishop Soto celebrating Benediction on the Cathedral landing and was followed by Mass. The Pilgrimage will culminate at the National Eucharistic Congress in July.



# A View through the Camera Lens



A camera is like a key. It can get you access. Access to things like a good vantage point at an event. Access to an excuse to be somewhere most people can't or shouldn't be.

Photography placed me in a unique position on the day of the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage's stop in Sacramento. Dawdling on the grey marble plateau before the iron doors, I waited for the pilgrims, who had processed through the streets with faithful Sacramentans, to come and celebrate Jesus Christ in the Eucharist, in gargantuan attendance at the Cathedral.

I would not have known much about this event had I not been in contact with someone who might've been the prophet Elijah: gracile, bald, a full, snowy beard. Jacket hung with pinback buttons that shouted "Viva Cristo Rey" or had the Sacred Heart on them. A bucket hat. He had his bony finger on the pulse of the pilgrims' journey, and relayed the details to me.

But nothing my prophet friend had said quite prepared me for the sight.

As we stood up on the steps overlooking Cathedral Square, we heard a tumult.

If you had opened your arms, you couldn't close them around all of the people, even from a distance. They flooded the square, and my spiritual jaw dropped.

They chanted as Christ was carried in the monstrance up the steps. I was penned in by

priests and struggled to find the right spot for a shot among the people kneeling all over the steps. I was somewhat successful. My competition crowded the small altar on its other side, and the cluster of cameras clicked and flashed. In the end I gave up and just looked at God, and he looked back at me. At us.

I kept looking over my shoulder to gape at the sea of faces. A smile split mine as I saw the Prophet hugging a lamp-post.

Somehow, the people were tucked into the pews. I balanced reverence and my errand as I snuck into most corners of the echoing church and captured candid.

In the Cathedral, someone plucked at my arm. A veiled elderly lady wanting to see some of the pictures I'd taken of the crowd out in the Square. I bent over, working the camera to show off the photographs. She cried quietly over how many people had come.

When it was time to kneel, the nave thundered.

I saw God in the staff working quietly to prepare food for the pilgrims, when I entered their territory in the lower level. I saw God in the veiled old lady and saw hope in the faith the people showed who had processed inside with Jesus.

The Perpetual Pilgrims' journey is a badly kept secret, a poorly muffled whisper, and it sounds something like, "God's still here."

And many cameras caught the evidence.

A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥128 (Mark谷2:18-22) Fr. Abraham Chiu 趙必成神父

當基督徒仍在禁食中掙扎時，比方是否吃龍蝦比吃肉更好，因為龍蝦是冷血動物；耶穌闡明禁食的真正精神。

法律規定唯一禁食日子是贖罪日（肋16:29；七月十日，必須克己並停止工作以進行悔改），但法利塞人加上額外禁食，每週兩次，落在週一和周四。在耶穌比喻中，他是默西亞新郎；意義是天國已經臨在人間，他是天國的主，如此歡樂情況，禁食好不兼容，伴郎理當慶祝，非哀悼。

耶穌說：“伴郎豈能在新郎還與他們在一起的時候禁食？”“與他們在一起”這句話的意思是“在婚禮慶典期間”。介詞“與”（*met'*）表示新郎與朋友共融。

使人離開天主的是罪，當耶穌門徒仍與他在一起時，享受與主共融。然而，當新郎被帶走，也就是人們拒絕天主時，以禁食為標記的哀悼就變得重要。當人心拋棄耶穌時，就是犯罪時刻，因此需要為與主和人的破裂關係而哀悼。

信徒常尋找與耶穌相遇途徑；然而，羞恥、內疚和罪過仍然存在生活當中，阻礙耶穌臨在。他告訴人們不要被經師和法利塞人的虛偽誤導，包括禁食時假裝哀悼。他撕破偽君子的面具，在日常生活中與我們以兄弟身份相遇。每當我們和耶穌一起，這都是盛大慶祝婚宴。

### Focus of the Gospel:

In our Gospel next Sunday, the Disciples find themselves in the middle of a storm on the Sea of Galilee. As hard as they try to row the boat, they are not getting anywhere. They are tired, the boat beginning to take in water and they are afraid of sinking. All the while, Jesus is there with them, asleep on a cushion. Not many of us have been in a boat during a storm. We have, however, been in storms of broken relationships, bad days at school/work, loss of jobs, loss of loved ones. In these moments we can feel like we are drowning and that God is absent (or asleep). Our Gospel next Sunday reminds us that God is indeed there with us and is taking care. Let us remain calm, resting with him in the boat, and hear Him say to our stormy heart: "Quiet! Be still!"

Mantengamos la calma, descansando con Él en la barca, y oigámosle decir a nuestro corazón tempestuoso «¡Silencio! Estate quieto!».

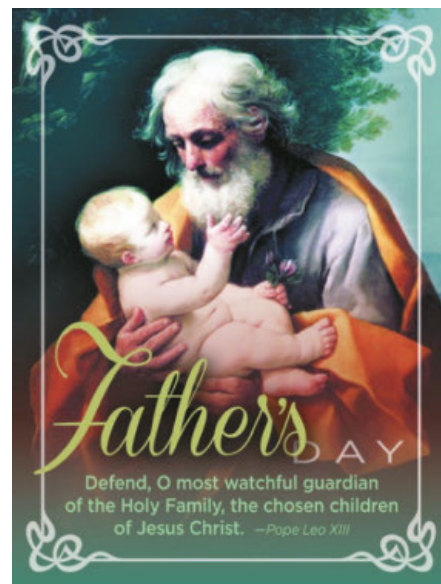

### GOSPEL MK 4:26-34

Jesus said to the crowds:

“This is how it is with the kingdom of God; it is as if a man were to scatter seed on the land and would sleep and rise night and day and through it all the seed would sprout and grow, he knows not how. Of its own accord the land yields fruit, first the blade, then the ear, then the full grain in the ear. And when the grain is ripe, he wields the sickle at once, for the harvest has come.”

He said, “To what shall we compare the kingdom of God, or what parable can we use for it? It is like a mustard seed that, when it is sown in the ground, is the smallest of all the seeds on the earth. But once it is sown, it springs up and becomes the largest of plants and puts forth large branches, so that the birds of the sky can dwell in its shade.” With many such parables he spoke the word to them as they were able to understand it. Without parables he did not speak to them, but to his own disciples he explained everything in private.

### EVANGELIO MC 4, 26-34

En aquel tiempo, Jesús dijo a la multitud: “El Reino de Dios se parece a lo que sucede cuando un hombre siembra la semilla en la tierra: que pasan las noches y los días, y sin que él sepa cómo, la semilla germina y crece; y la tierra, por sí sola, va produciendo el fruto: primero los tallos, luego las espigas y después los granos en las espigas. Y cuando ya están maduros los granos, el hombre echa mano de la hoz, pues ha llegado el tiempo de la cosecha”.

Les dijo también: “¿Con qué compararemos el Reino de Dios? ¿Con qué parábola lo podremos representar? Es como una semilla de mostaza que, cuando se siembra, es la más pequeña de las semillas; pero una vez sembrada, crece y se convierte en el mayor de los arbustos y echa ramas tan grandes, que los pájaros pueden anidar a su sombra”.

Y con otras muchas parábolas semejantes les estuvo exponiendo su mensaje, de acuerdo con lo que ellos podían entender. Y no les hablaba sino en parábolas; pero a sus discípulos les explicaba todo en privado.

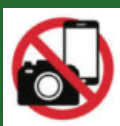

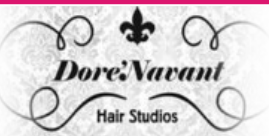

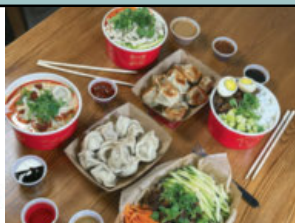
