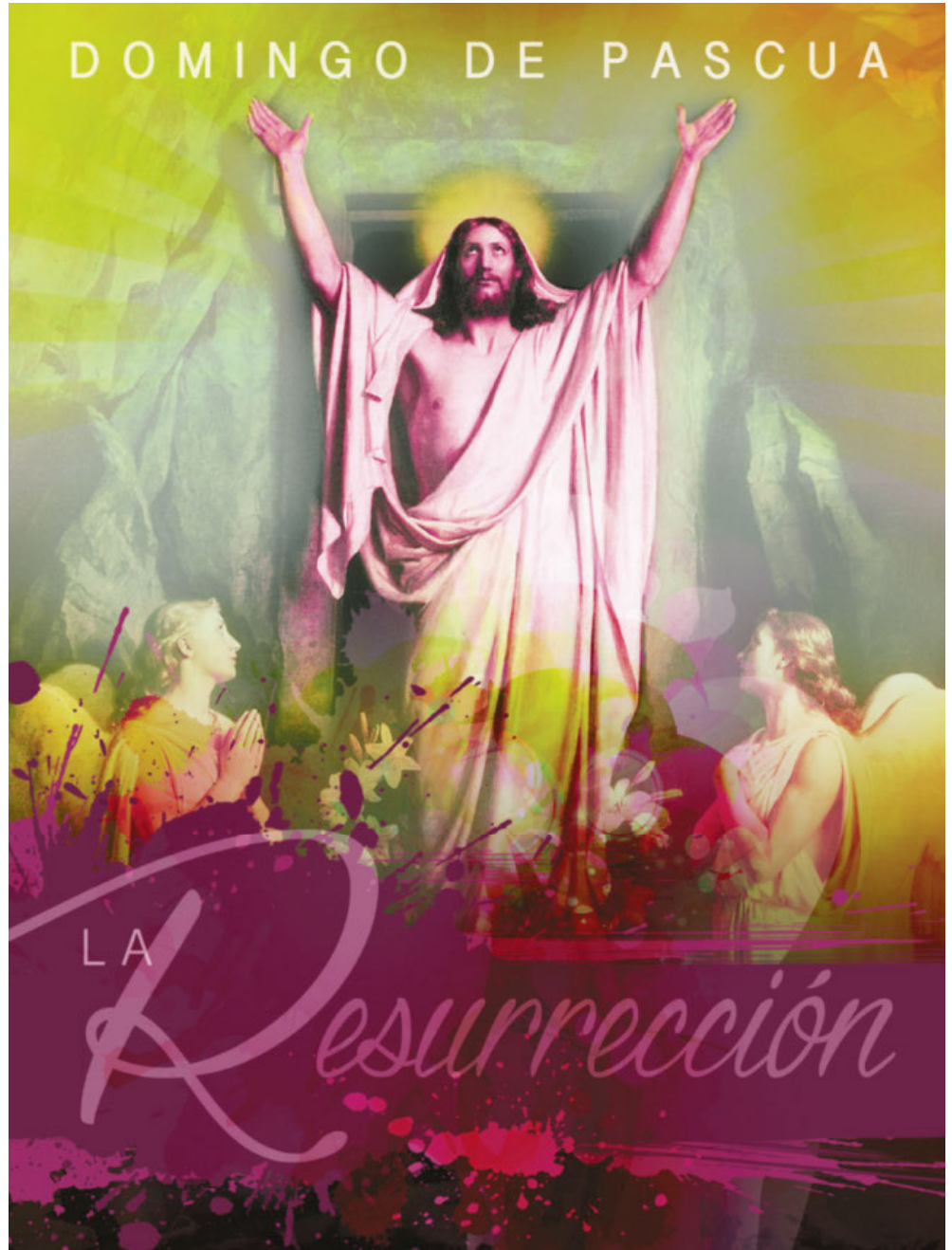

A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥 118 (Mark 谷1:1-8) Fr. Abraham Chiu 趙必成神父

2,000 years ago, John recommended a baptism of repentance in the river Jordan to the Jews because John was sent by God to speak for the coming of Jesus. In fact, the most important issue of human life is to look to Jesus. In order to show Jesus' love to people, John's ministry was effective primarily because his life was his message: he lived what he preached and he preached what he lived. That makes his preaching powerful and touching. He finally paid a high price when he exhorted Herod to leave Herodia.

John's message was effective also because he was completely humble. His role was to serve Jesus and the people. "After me comes he who is mightier than I, the thong of whose sandals I am not worthy to stoop down and untie." He frankly admitted that he was the messiah's humble messenger, preparing a straight way for the messiah in the heart and lives of the Jews. The Israelites had not had a prophet for three hundred years and now, they finally had expected one, who is John.

John said, "I have baptized you with water; but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit." Baptism with water is only a ritual to express repentance but with respect to eternal life, this grace must come from the paschal mystery of Jesus, i.e. his death and resurrection. What the best gift from Jesus to humans is the source of eternal life, the Holy Spirit. This "Spirit" (Pneumati) is "holy" (Hagiō). That is to say, this divine spirit will lead all penitents to God's kingdom with no doubts. It also opposes the evil spirit that pushes people to hell. The Holy Spirit is God's justice indicating that whoever repent and follow Jesus will be saved into eternal life.

What should we do for justice? John's preaching reminds us of our important task of announcing Jesus to others through our lives everywhere. When we show real love, kindness, mercy, and a spirit of forgiveness we are announcing the truth that Jesus is with us. Then, how to show a spirit of forgiveness that the world is mostly needy? We have to be aware of two reasons why we fail to receive forgiveness. The first is that we fail to repent, and the second is that we fail to forgive. Take John as our good example that we can make the winding road straight. Otherwise, our silence to injustice prevents people from accepting Jesus as our God. Let us not allow what others have done to destroy our life.

兩千年前，若翰向猶太人宣講悔改的洗禮，因他是天主派來為耶穌預備道路。事實上，人生最重要的，莫過跟隨耶穌。為了宣講耶穌的愛，若翰以言以行，生活的，是他宣講的，宣講的，就是他生活的，因此他的宣講鏗鏘有力。尤其當他勸黑落德離開黑落狄雅時，付出極高代價。

若翰的道理之所以有效，因他謙虛。他只是為耶穌與人們服務：“那比我更有力量，要在我以後來，我連俯身解他的鞋帶也不配。”他坦言自己是默西亞的卑微使者，只是為耶穌在以色列子民當中鋪路。以色列人已經三百年沒有先知，現在，他們終於等到一位，是若翰。

若翰說：“我以水洗你們，他卻要以聖神洗你們。”水洗只是表達悔改的儀式；永生，就要來自耶穌的逾越奧蹟，即他的死亡復活。耶穌賜人最佳禮物，是永生泉源：聖神。這“神” (Pneumati) 是“聖” (Hagiō) 的，也就是說，聖神毫無疑問地帶領所有悔改者進入天國，不像邪神推人到地獄。聖神是天主的正義，凡悔改跟隨耶穌的，都將得救進入永生。

為了正義，基督徒該做什麼？若翰提醒，是透過生活向普世宣講耶穌傳揚福音。當活出真正仁愛、慈悲和寬恕時，就在宣告耶穌與人同在的真理。

為什麼寬恕那麼困難？困難在於拒絕悔改，還有漠視寬恕。那麼，如何寬恕？可以積極跟若翰學習：“預備上主的道路，修直他的途徑。”其實，基督徒對不正義事保持沉默，會阻止世界接受耶穌為主；被邪惡世界毀掉我們永生，不值。

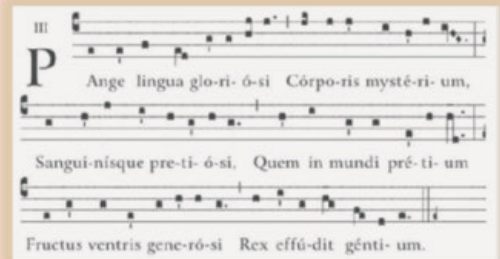

Christ is Risen! Alleluia!



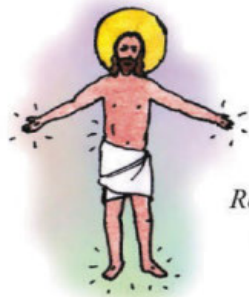
Easter is the time when we celebrate Jesus' rising from the dead.

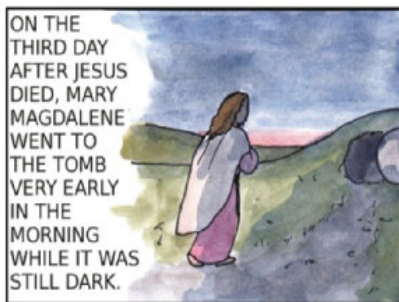

Focus of the Gospel:

Doubt and Fear. These are the two central emotions running through the Disciples in the Gospel for next week. We pick up the story following the wild tale of Mary Magdalene that the body was gone. The Disciples locked themselves away in the upper room because they were afraid they would be hunted down by the ones who arrested Jesus. They were full of doubt whether Jesus was truly risen like he said he would. If he was risen, where was he? He appears to them and their fear turns to joy. But Thomas was not with them, and continued to doubt because he needed proof in order to put his trust in Jesus. We are invited as we move through the coming weeks of Easter to “believe without seeing”. Next week is also Divine Mercy Sunday, which reminds us of when Jesus appeared to St. Faustina with the words, “**Jesus, I Trust in You**”. We are called to trust without seeing. This is what FAITH is all about. And you? Are you able to believe Jesus is with us here and is ready to heal with His mercy?

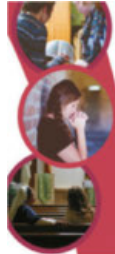

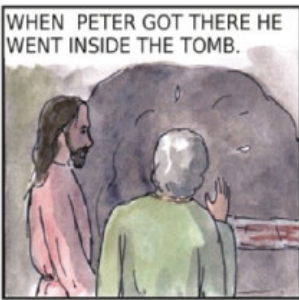

Peter proceeded to speak and said:

“You know what has happened all over Judea, beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John preached, how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power. 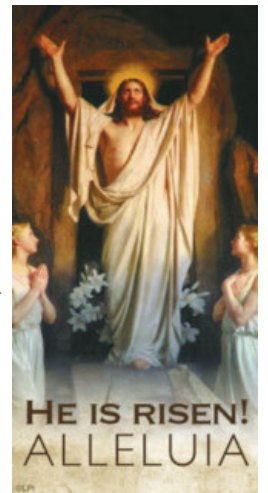

GOSPEL JN 20:1-9

On the first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb early in the morning, while it was still dark, and saw the stone removed from the tomb. So she ran and went to Simon Peter and to the other disciple whom Jesus loved, and told them, “They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we don’t know where they put him.” So Peter and the other disciple went out and came to the tomb. They both ran, but the other disciple ran faster than Peter and arrived at the tomb first; he bent down and saw the burial cloths there, but did not go in. When Simon Peter arrived after him, he went into the tomb and saw the burial cloths there, and the cloth that had covered his head, not with the burial cloths but rolled up in a separate place. Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed. For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead.

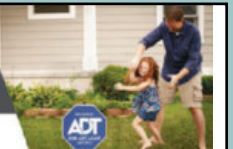

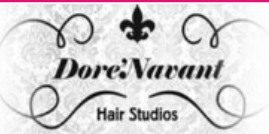
