A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥 126 (Mark 2:13-17) Fr. Abraham Chiu 趙必成神父

耶穌怎樣看人？

稅吏被猶太人視為賣國賊而加以憎恨和蔑視；他們被禁止進入猶太教堂，並被法利塞人視為不潔罪人，相當於強盜和殺人犯。當他人在肋未身上只看到貪婪和背叛、欺騙和詭詐時，耶穌卻在他身上看到一個需要主愛和恩寵的人。當每人敵視歧視肋未，耶穌卻給他毫無保留的慈悲大愛和寬恕。

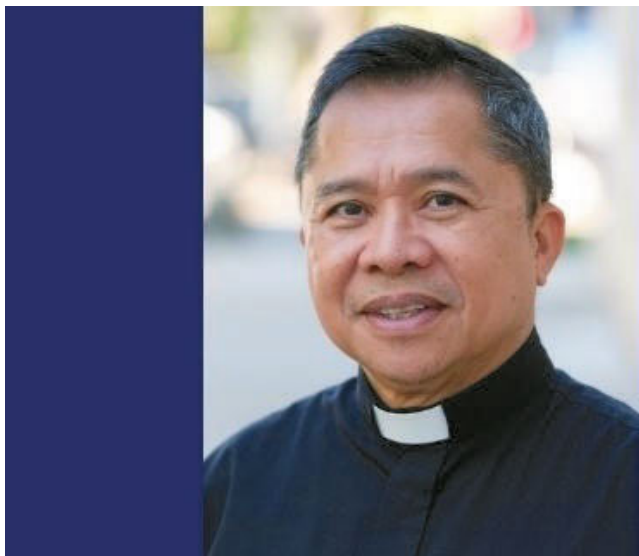
為了跟隨耶穌，肋未毅然放棄賺大錢的工作，雖然知道永遠無法重新獲得它。在放下舒適、安全及財富之後，他只想跟隨耶穌。對肋未來說，耶穌的召叫，是救恩的應許。這召叫核心，表示耶穌歡迎各樣的人進入他的教會，因為耶穌願意接受稅吏為徒。

當耶穌受到經師攻擊時，他從兩個層面反擊他們的攻擊。首先，耶穌強調他作為治療者的職責：“不是健康的人需要醫生，而是有病的人。”耶穌聲稱，他來，是邀請那些深度意識到自己的罪並迫切需要救主的人；其次，耶穌給了軟弱門徒神聖鼓勵：“我不是來召義人，而是召罪人。”

形容詞“義”（dikaios）表示在天主眼中的正義或公義；這裡諷刺那些自以為義的法利塞人，他們不是耶穌召叫對象，因為他們如此自滿，確信自己不需任何幫助。

被耶穌召叫是白白恩寵，因為召叫不是因為人們有多優秀（格前1:26-28）。耶穌在賣國賊家裡與被遺棄的人一起吃飯，讓法利塞人感到震驚，但為了救贖罪人，這宴席是天國永生的預嘗。

Vayan, pues, y enseñen a todas las naciones, bautizándolas en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo, y enseñándolas a cumplir todo cuanto yo les he mandado; y sepan que yo estaré con ustedes todos los días, hasta el fin del mundo”.

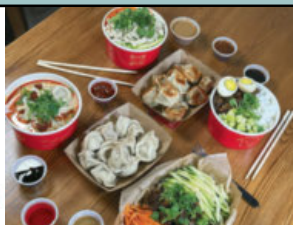
