A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥 127 (Mark 1:29-39)

Fr. Abraham Chiu 趙必成神父

耶穌施行奇蹟，啟示天主治療人間疾苦的慈悲大愛。第二天清早，門徒在荒野找到正在祈禱的耶穌，他們建議他回到曾經牧民成功的地方。耶穌回答：“讓我們到別處去，到鄰近的村鎮去罷！好叫我也在那裡宣講，因為我是為這事出來的。”這表明耶穌的天主使命與他門徒所期望的完全不同。耶穌所言所行表明一個事實：福傳目標不是為個人虛榮，而是天國。指示代名詞“這事”（*touto*）指的是天主使命，即人類救贖。耶穌是從天父那裡被派遣出來，他以此解釋他出來的原因；在若16:28他也說了同樣的話：“我出自父，來到了世界上。”耶穌無意成為眾人矚目的焦點或所謂“成功”，而是忠於天主旨意。他來是為帶給所有人救恩和祝福。他用自己的力量為人的生活帶來治癒和完整。值得注意的，是耶穌離開相對安全的葛法翁，前往其他城鎮村莊，冒著遭到反對甚至死亡風險。事實上，有些基督徒可能會猶豫是否要為耶穌冒險，以免帶來麻煩。為主作證需要屬神力量，耶穌也深信，如果他要透過福傳及治療牧職來服事眾人，這奉獻自己的行動，沒有祈禱是無法實踐。德蘭修女曾說：“天主並沒有召叫我成功，他召叫我要忠貞。”在人看來，耶穌並不成功，尤其當他被釘死在十字架上時；然而，在天主眼裡，耶穌是忠貞的。

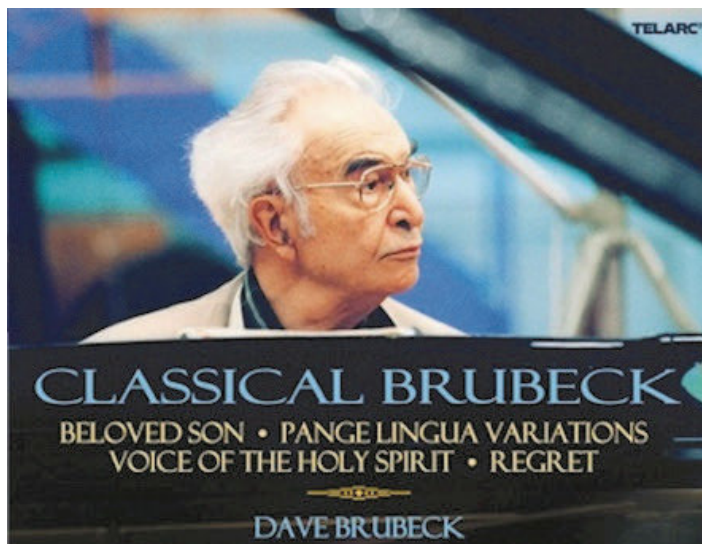

In 1983 the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament commissioned legendary musician Dave Brubeck to compose a variation of the Thomas Aquinas hymn “Pange Lingua, Gloriosi” (“Sing, My Tongue, the Savior’s Glory”). The work beautifully captures the poetic spirit of the original Gregorian chant combined with jazz interludes. It was Brubeck’s first sacred composition since

he had converted to Catholicism. The Dave Brubeck Quartet first performed the work in the Cathedral with orchestra and chorus over two nights in May 1983 to sell-out audiences.

On July 6 the Emmy-nominated Chris Brubeck Trio (Dave’s sons) will join the Cathedral Choir and Orchestra to recreate this beautiful work in a Eucharistic Revival Concert. Tickets are now on sale at <https://cbssac.ticketspice.com/brubeck>. Ticket prices range from \$25 to \$75. A wine-and-cheese reception will precede the concert at a cost of \$50.

Focus of the Gospel:

The Readings next Sunday speak a lot about planting, and about trees. Anyone who has done some gardening knows, that it takes time to see the new growth when a seed is planted. Some of the most important work of that seed takes place in the dark, hidden under the topsoil, until finally the new shoots break through and show themselves. Imagine each of us are seeds and God is the farmer. He plants us where he wills and waits for us to take root. He—unlike human farmers—knows how we are made, and he knows our full potential. Are you letting God shape you, prune you, prepare you to be the best you can be? Will you let Him who knows your whole being be the one who guides your life?

READING 1 GN 3:9-15

After the man, Adam, had eaten of the tree, the LORD God called to the man and asked him, "Where are you?" He answered, "I heard you in the garden; but I was afraid, because I was naked, so I hid myself." Then he asked, "Who told you that you were naked? You have eaten, then, from the tree of which I had forbidden you to eat!" The man replied, "The woman whom you put here with me—she gave me fruit from the tree, and so I ate it." Brothers and sisters:

Since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, I believed, therefore I spoke, we too believe and therefore we speak, knowing that the one who raised the Lord Jesus will raise us also with Jesus and place us with you in his presence. Everything indeed is for you, so that the grace bestowed in abundance on

more and more people may cause the thanksgiving to overflow for the glory of God. Therefore, we are not discouraged; rather, although our outer self is wasting away, our inner self is being renewed day by day. For this momentary light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison, as we look not to what is seen but to what is unseen; for what is seen is transitory, but what is unseen is eternal. For we know that if our earthly dwelling, a tent, should be destroyed, we have a building from God, a dwelling not made with hands, eternal in heaven.

When his relatives heard of this they set out to seize him, for they said, "He is out of his mind." The scribes who had come from Jerusalem said, "He is possessed by Beelzebul," and "By the prince of demons he drives out demons."

Summoning them, he began to speak to them in parables, "How can Satan drive out Satan? If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. And if a house is divided against itself, that house will not be able to stand. And if Satan has risen up against himself and is divided, he cannot stand; that is the end of him. But no one can enter a strong man's house to plunder his property unless he first ties up the strong man. Then he can plunder the house. EVANGELIO MC 3, 20-35

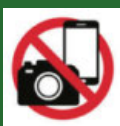

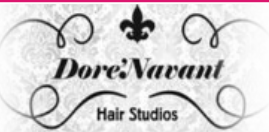
